

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 143 OF SECTION 2-2-B
[DEFINITIONS – OBSOLETE VEHICLE] OF THE UTAH COUNTY
ZONING ORDINANCE

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UTAH

ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

PART I:

Subsection 143 of Section 2-2-B of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

143. Vehicle, Obsolete

A used vehicle which lacks a current license and state registration, or a used vehicle which is not in running order without adding parts or repairs.

(Exception to the "current license and state registration" standard: a type of vehicle which is not required under Utah State law to be registered and have a license to be operated on public roads, such as a trailer under 750 pound gross unladen weight.)

PART II:

Insert pages reflecting the above amendments are hereby ordered to be filed in the three file copies of the Official Utah County Zone Map on file with the Utah County Clerk.

PART VIII:

This ordinance shall take effect: 1. fifteen (15) days after it is passed, or 2. after it has been published, whichever date is later.
