

ORDINANCE NO. 2004 - 19

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE UTAH COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE, SPECIFICALLY SECTIONS 2-2-B [DEFINITIONS] TO DEFINE "GRADING," GRAVEL, AND "ROADS, STRUCTURAL CLASSIFICATION OF STRUCTURAL TYPES"**

**THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UTAH ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**PART I:**

Section 2-2-B [Definitions] of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to add a new subsection 61.5, entitled "Grading" which shall read as follows:

61.5 Grading

The excavation or removal of earth material by artificial means, the filling or deposition of earth material by artificial means, or the combination thereof.

**PART II:**

Section 2-2-B [Definitions] of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to delete subsection 62.5 [Graveled Road], and to add a new subsection 62.5, entitled "Gravel," which shall read as follows:

62.5 Gravel

Rock material which passes through a 1-inch or smaller screen but which is too large to pass through a 2 millimeter or smaller screen.

**PART III:**

Subsection 97.5 [paved road] of section 2-2-B [Definitions] of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby deleted.

**PART IV:**

Section 2-2-B [Definitions] of the Utah County Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to add a new

subsection 115.5, entitled "Roads, Classification of Structural Types," which shall read as follows:

115.5 Roads, Classification of Structural Types

All roads and driveways shall be classified into one of the following structural types:

a. Gravel Road.

A road structure that (a) is built up, graded and drained by transverse drainage systems to prevent serious impairment of the road surface by surface water; (b) is constructed with a sufficient underlayment of subsurface material and gravel surfacing to meet AASHTO H20-44 loading standards for bridges and roads (equivalent to certain 20-ton truck loads), and (c) is capable of supporting fire trucks and other heavy vehicles during any season of the year. [AASHTO is the acronym for the American Association of Highway and Transportation Officials]

b. Light-duty Road

A lower quality road which meets neither the definition of this ordinance for a paved road nor a graveled road. There may be some patches of gravel surfacing, but the road as a whole does not meet AASHTO engineering standards for H20-44 loading.

c. Paved Road

A road structure that has been built up with a suitable base and sub-base, and which has the travel surface covered by asphalt, concrete, or some other bound-together, hard-surface paving material (not magnesium chloride, gravel, or dirt).

**PART V:**

Insert pages reflecting the above amendments are hereby ordered to be filed in the three file copies of the Official Utah County Zone Map on file with the Utah County Clerk.

**PART VI:**

This ordinance shall take effect: 1. fifteen (15) days after it is passed, or 2. after it has been published, whichever date is later.

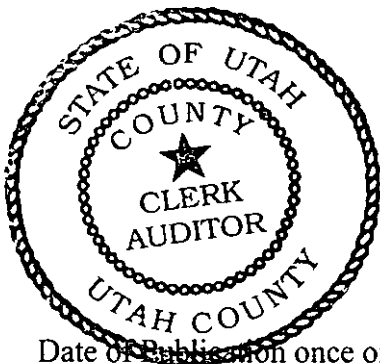
