What is a Comprehensive Plan?

- A comprehensive plan is a document that states a community's desired vision for the future.
- It consists of a single plan or coordinated set of plans organized by subject and sometimes geographic area.
- It will include a Land Use Strategy, Development, Infrastructure and Public Services Strategy, Economic / Fiscal Strategy, Mobility Strategy, and Strategic Investment Areas Strategy.
- While a comprehensive plan states the community's vision for the future, it does not constitute zoning regulations or establish zoning district boundaries.

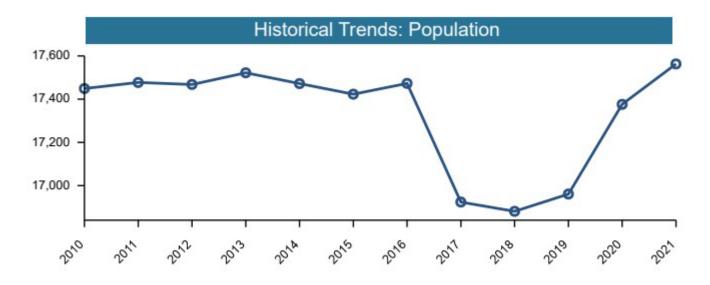

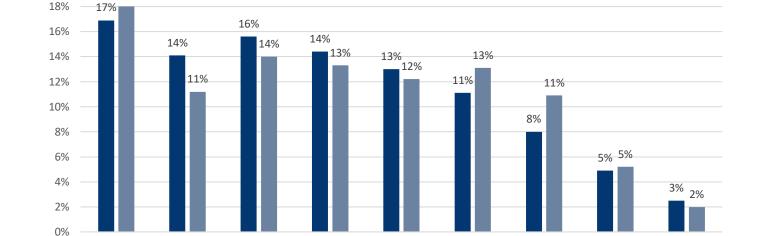

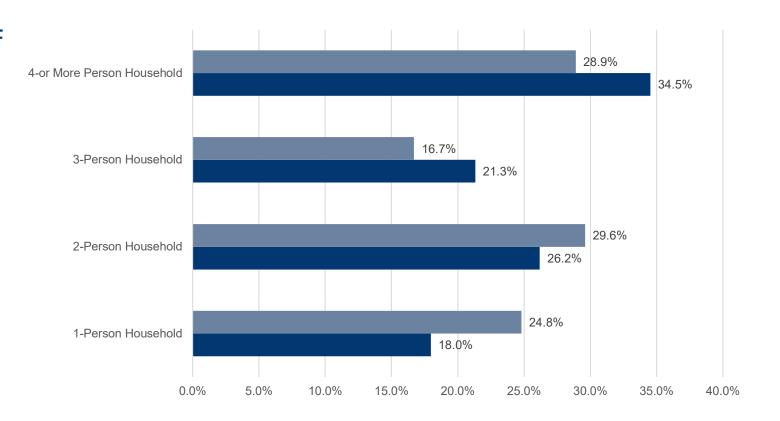

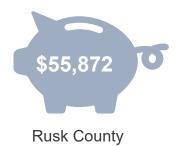


Income Characteristics

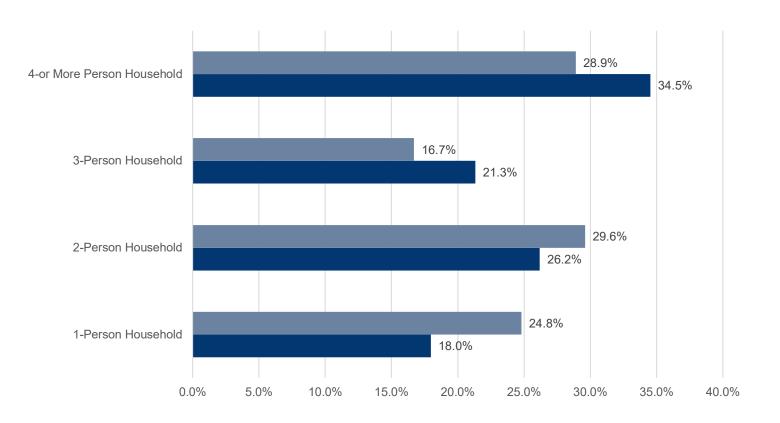


COMPARISON OF HOUSEHOLDS BY INCOME

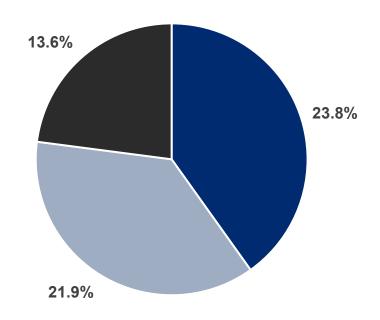


Psychographics

HEARTLAND COMMUNITIES

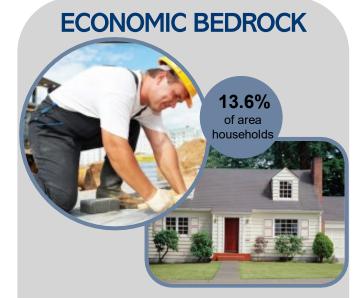


- These older householders are primarily homeowners and many have paid off their mortgages..

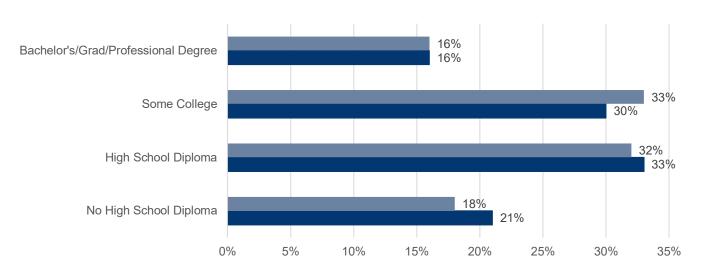

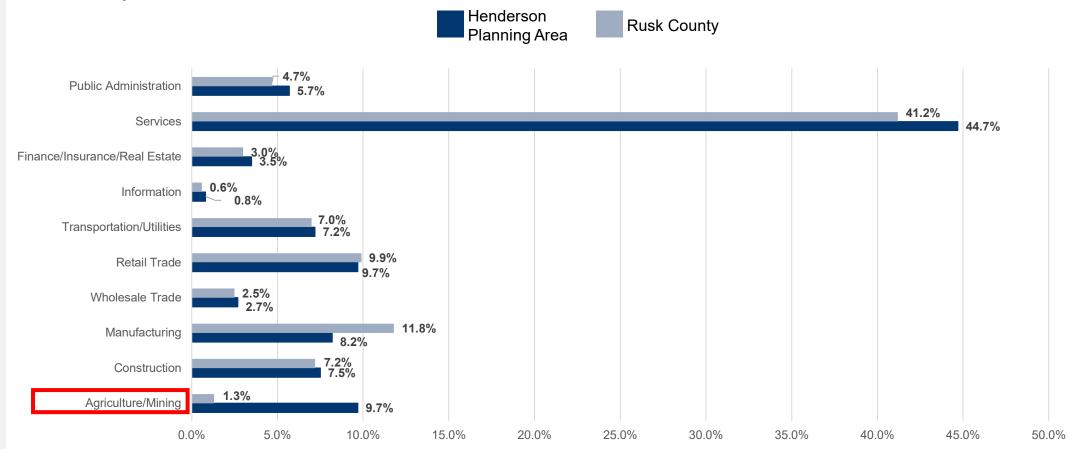

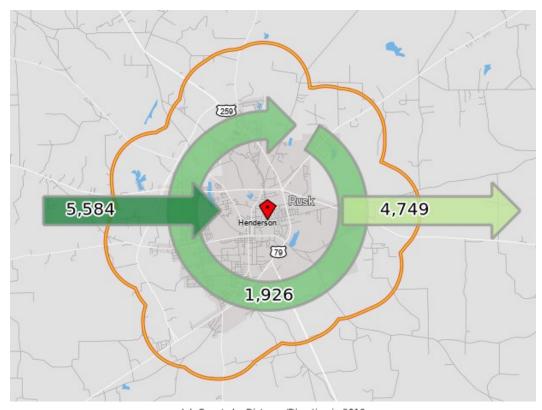


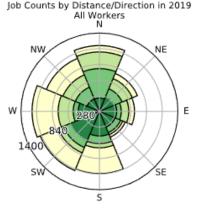
Commuting Patterns

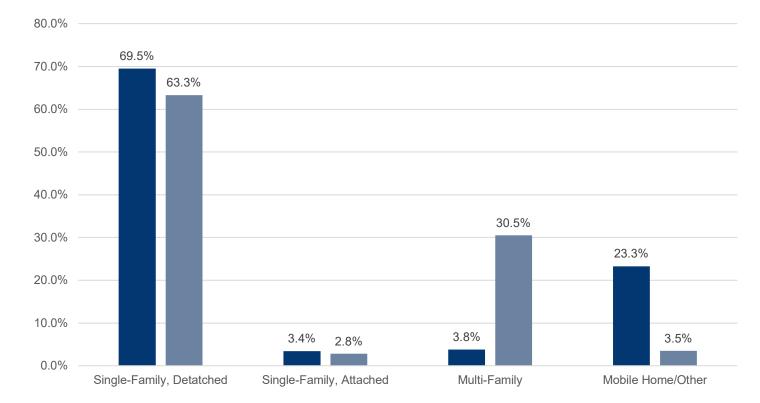
