Measurements:

6" X 6" piece of Designer Series Paper.

Insert:

1 piece 2" X 1 3/4" and 1 piece 2 1/8" X 1 7/8".

Directions:

1. Place 6" X 6" paper on the envelope punch board, lining up the edge of the paper at 1 3/8". Punch and Score.
2. Slide paper down to 4", punch and score.
3. Turn paper. Line up the score line (don't use the ruler, use the score line!). Punch and score. Continue this on the remaining 3 sides.
4. Using the Corner Rounder on the backside of the punch board, round the corners of each tab.
5. Looking at the paper, notice that 2 sides are wider than the others. On the wide sides, Cut on each side of the tab up to the first score line.
6. Fold together the larger flaps, (these are the handles), line them up and punch with 3" inch punch.
7. Adhere the lower front and back flaps with glue dots.
8. Pull the side flaps outward and adhere each with a glue dot.
9. Place a glue dot on the very top of the handle to keep the handles from coming apart. (this is optional)
10. Embellish. For this project I've used the Stitched Felt Embellishments and adhered them with
