Supplies:

- Stamp Set:** Country Livin' Clear-Mount Stamp Set – 141925, Wood - 141922
- **Cardstock:** Very Vanilla – 101650, Soft Suede – 115318, Wood Textures Designer Series Paper Stack – 144177, Copper Foil Sheets - 142020
- Stampin' Pad:** Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad - 132708
- Mics:** Swirly Scribbles Thinlits Dies – 141497, Happy Birthday Thinlits Die – 143700, Multipurpose Adhesive Sheets – 144106, Everyday Label Punch – 144668, Multipurpose Liquid Glue – 110755, Stampin' Dimensionals - 104430

Measurement:

- Very Vanilla 11 x 4¼ score at 2¼ and 5½, 3½ x 3
- Wood Textures Designer Paper 3 x 3½, 4¼ x 2½, 2 of 4¼ x 1¼, Everyday Label Punch Out
- Soft Suede 3¼ x 3¾, 3½ x 3, 2 x 2
- Copper Foil 3 x 3
- Adhesive sheet 6 x 3½

Instruction:

1. Fold the scored Very Vanilla cardstock in half then at the 2¼ score fold back.
2. Adhere the 4¼ x 2½ onto the left side of the front of the card.
3. Inside adhere the 2 strips of 4¼ x 1¼ into the center one on the left and one on the right.
4. Die cut the swirl out the copper foil and adhere at the inside the bottom right.
5. Stamp the boots using memento black ink onto Soft Suede.
6. Hand cut and adhere onto of the copper swirl using dimensionals.
7. Place the Very Vanilla and Soft Suede 3 x 3½ in between the adhesive sheet.

8. Place the Happy Birthday Die onto the Very Vanilla and die cut repeat on the Soft Suede.
9. Place the Soft Suede Happy Birthday overlap onto the Very Vanilla.
10. Adhere onto the Wood Texture $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3$, then adhere into the $3\frac{1}{4} \times 3\frac{3}{4}$ soft suede
11. Adhere the everyday Label wood texture punch out onto the front bottom flap.
12. Adhere the Happy Birthday panel into the front flap. ONLY apply adhesive in the center of the flap so it can flip open.
