

Envelope Fold Tidings of Christmas

This card is cased from Dina Kowal from a Splitcoast Stampers post.

1. The card base of Soft Succulent is cut 5 1/2 X 8 1/2.
2. On the 8 1/2" side make a mark at 2 3/4. Then score at 4 1/2. Flip the card over (front to back) and make another mark at 2 3/4 that is opposite the previous one.
3. Turn the card to the 5 1/2" side, placing the end with the marks at the top. Make a mark at 2 3/4. This is the center of the 5 1/2.
4. You can use a ruler or scoreboard and make a score line from the center mark on the end of the card to each of the side score marks. This makes a triangle.
5. Using the triangle score lines as a guide, cut off the two side pieces. This leaves the point you see on the front of the card in the photo above. (You can do this without making the scorelines. Simply place the center mark and a side mark on your paper trimmer and cut that triangle off. Then repeat for the opposite side. Do whichever makes you most comfortable.)
6. Cut a piece of Tidings Of Christmas Designer Series Paper to 3 1/2 X 3 1/2. Cut the square on the diagonal to make two triangles. One triangle is the piece you layer over the triangle on the front of the base card you just cut.
7. Adhere the large triangle to the front pointed section of the card. See left photo above.
8. Take the second DSP triangle and place the flat bottom against the top of the paper trimmer, align the point with the cutting groove and cut that one in half. They become the side pieces for the inside of the card.
9. Cut a piece of Sahara Sand Cardstock to 4 X 5 1/4. Stamp the inside sentiment and the small poinsettia in Cherry Cobbler Ink. The poinsettia is stamped off first.
10. Adhere the two triangle small pieces to each corner. See the right side picture above. They

are layered edge to edge with no border showing on the Sahara Sand.

11. Cut a piece of Misty Moonlight cardstock to 1 1/4 X 5 1/4
12. Cut a piece of Sahara Sand cardstock to 1 1/8 X 5 1/8. Stamp the Merry Christmas on the Sahara Sand using Cherry Cobbler Ink and adhere to the Misty Moonlight. Adhere the layers to the top of the front of the card.
13. Die cut three sizes of the poinsettia flower from Cherry Cobbler cardstock.
14. Die cut two of the centers using Gold Metallic Paper. Use the ribbon hole on the Delightful Tag Topper Punch to make the center for the smallest flower.
15. Adhere the flowers as shown on my card.
