

- 1. This card is made using the Playing In The Rain Bundle and Dandy Designs Designer Series Paper. Petal Pink Card stock.
- 2. Cut the Petal Pink card stock to 5 1/2 X 8 1/2 and score on the 8 1/2 side at 1 1/2, 3, and 5 3/4. Fold and burnish make mountain and valley folds as you see in the photo.
- 3. Cut a second piece of Petal Pink card stock to 8 1/2 X 3 1/4. Score it at 4 1/4, fold and burnish.
- 4. Cut a piece of Basic White card stock to 5 1/4 X 2 1/2. Adhere it to the inside of the taller fold on the multi-fold piece. This is your place to write your greeting and sign.
- 5. DSP for the front of that section is cut to 5 1/4 X 2 1/2 as well. I used Dandy Designs Designer Series Paper. (The flowers are the opposite side of the tiles beneath the turtle)
- 6. DSP for the smaller step section is cut to 5 1/4 X 1 1/4.
- 7. The DSP for the turtle layer is the tiled piece. It is cut 3 X 4 and adhered to the front.
- 8. After adhering all of the pieces to the multi fold section, lay it out flat. Take the other Petal Pink piece (the turtle card) and lay it on top of the multi. Center it in equal distance on each side and line up with the front and back ends. They should line up perfectly. One at a time, adhere the top piece to the section at each end. Be sure to only adhere to the one section on each end, or the folds will not work. (Think of the turtle card as being a tent over top of the step card! And only adhered where it touches the front and the back)
- 9. Using Layering Circles Dies, cut a piece of Fresh Freesia using the larger circle that is approximately 2 1/2".
- 10. On scrap Basic White, stamp the turtle using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink and color with Stampin' Blends. I took color liberties and used Pale Papaya for the underside, and Calypso Coral for the shell. The flowers are Fresh Freesia. Then die cut the turtle using the dies from Playing In The Rain Bundle.
- 11. Glue these pieces to the front of the card as shown.
- 12. Tie a bow around the front of the tall section using the Fresh Freesia Open Weave Ribbon.
