Pop Up Floating Shadow Box Card

- 1. This card is cased from Lisa Cursio and she has a YouTube video for directions.
- 2. Cut Pumpkin Pie cardstock to 4 1/4 X 11 and score at 1 1/2 and 5 1/2. Cut a second piece to 4 1/4 X 7 with the same scoring.
- 3. Using the Deckled Rectangle Dies, use the 4th up from smallest, and cut the window of the shorter cardstock between the two score lines. See right photo.
- 4. Using the Caring Leaves stamp set, stamp images around the Die cut opening using Pumpkin Pie ink.
- 5. Cut DSP from the To Market Designer Series Paper at 2 @ 4 X 3 3/4, and 1 @ 4 X 1 1/4. Adhere one of the larger to the front of the card base and one to the small section of card base. See left photo. The second of the larger pieces goes behind the pop up later.
- 6. To create the "floating" window, cut a strip of Window Sheet that is 3/4 X 3 7/8. Add this with two glue dots on each end to the back side of the window cut out and centered in the window and between the two score lines.
- 7. Cut a piece of Garden Green using the 3rd from smallest of the Dies. Adhere it to the back of the window sheet strip. The window sheet strip will be sandwiched between the green and the white sentiment when finished.
- 8. Cut a piece of Basic White using the 2nd smallest of the Dies for the window sentiment. Cut another using the 3rd smallest from Basic White, and one using Garden Green that is the 4th smallest. The two larger green and white are the front sentiment layer of the card.
- 9. After stamping the sentiments, the smallest White is layered on top of the window strip and the Garden Green in the Floating Window. The larger is layered on the largest Garden Green and is centered on the largest section of the card front.
- 10. The sentiments are from the Autumn Leaves stamp set. The Die Cut leaves on the front and window are from the Autumn Leaves Die set. And are cut using additional DSP from To Market Designer Series Paper. Cut two of the Maple Leaf and four of the Oak Leaf. Adhere the leaves as shown in photos. **on the window, the leaves are adhered to the Pumpkin Pie and not the "floating window".
- 11. To put the box together, open the card base and the window section, add adhesive to the top of the upper small section. Align it with the small section of the card base just to the score line. The card base section is on top. Turn the card base upside down and fold the window section so that the opposite end is sticking out. Add adhesive to this and close the back section of the card base. This should perfectly align the two.
- 12. The final step is to add that last piece of DSP behind the window.
