




- 1. This card layout requires almost a full sheet of 8 1/2 X 11 cardstock. The card base is **Blackberry Bliss** cut to 5 1/2 X 11. (4 1/4 X 11 is a half sheet)
- 2. Cutting the angles on each end are the same measurements on each end. After cutting the card base, score from each end at 3 3/8. Then using your **paper trimmer** or ruller, make a pencil mark on the left and right ends at 1" down from the top.
- 3. Next make a pencil mark on each end at the bottom 1" in from the end.
- 4. Now place one end of the cardstock on your paper trimmer with the top of the score line on the cutting line and the 1" pencil mark that is down from the top. Cut from the pencil mark to the score line. Looking at the center photo, you are making that top angle.
- 5. Next, place the point you just made at that 1" down mark in the cutting line as well as the 1" in mark at the bottom of the card. Cut between those two. Again, looking at the center

- photo you can see the cuts.
- 6. Repeat the 3-4 steps on the opposite end.
- 7. The DSP used is from the new **Host Rewards** pack of **Design A Daydream Designer Series Paper**.
- 8. To make the angle cuts on the DSP you do the same as the card base. The two pieces of DSP are both cut to 3 1/8 X 5 1/4. However, you can do both pieces at one time. BUT...to do this, pick your two patterns. Place the two pieces with the patterns you want to see one facing forward and one backward. Like their backs are to each other. If they are both in the same direction when you flip one of them, it will not be the pattern you want. And you can do these individually as you did each end of the card base.
- 9. Make sure your DSP pieces are positioned properly. Then make the 1" mark down from the top, and 1" mark in from the bottom. Place on your paper trimmer with the 1" mark down from top in the cutting track as well as the opposite top corner. Cut, then cut from the 1" down mark to the 1" in mark at the bottom. The two pieces should fit perfectly on your card.
- 10. Fold and burnish the card score lines. The two flaps can go either one on top. Add the DSP pieces to the flaps. The inside layer is 4 X 5 1/4.
- 11. The piggy is from the **This Birthday Piggy** stamp set. The **Basic White** layer is cut 3 X 2 1/2. Piggy is stamped with **Memento Tuxedo Black Ink** and colored with the following **Stampin' Blends**: Blackberry Bliss, Basic Black, Smoky Slate, Petal Pink, and Crumb Cake.
- 12. The pinwheel at the top of the Happy Birthday Flag was fussy cut from a scrap of the pinwheel DSP. It is adhered with a Mini Stampin' Dimensional just in the center.
- 13. The WEEEEE is stamped using **Crushed Curry Ink** and punched using the smaller oval on the **Double Oval Punch**. The inside sentiment is from the stamp set also.

Here is a template for the card base. And to cut the DSP would be the same as each end, or do together as long as positioned properly.
