## Using the Layers Of Beauty Masks For The Flower Cluster

Cut a Basic White cardstock layer 4 1/4" x 5 1/2". This should be large enough to stamp the flower cluster image. Stamp the image using Tuxedo Black Memento Ink.

Position your layer onto a protected surface. Grid Paper works well. Attach the stamped card layer to the Grid Paper. I used low tack tape.

Begin inking the image using the Masks (Stencils) as outlined in the photos below. Note that when you're applying ink to the image, use a circular motion. Start inking off the image and move onto the image. Apply more ink to your brush as needed.

- Start with Bubble Bath ink and Mask #1
- Use Petunia Pop Ink for Mask #2
- Use Berry Burst Ink for Mask #3
