Pocket Gift Card Holder



Paper Cutting Dimensions:

- Cut patterned paper 6" x 9 1/4". This is for the patterned paper pocket envelope.
- Score the patterned paper at 2 3/4" and 7" on the long side.
- Rotate the patterned paper and score the edge (on the long side) at 5/8".
- Cut along the 5/8" score line you just made down to the first horizontal score line.
- Lift the blade, start at the second horizontal score line and cut from that score line to the end of thepatterned paper. See photo below.



- Fold the pocket on the right and left score lines and burnish.
- Adhere the ends together with tape or glue. Next, fold the bottom tab up and adhere.
- Using a circle punch or die, cut a circle in the middle of the top of the pocket. See below.



Gift Card Insert:

- Cut the cardstock insert 6 1/4" x 4". I used Cherry Cobbler cardstock.
- Score at 1". This is the bottom flap.


- Attach a 5" x 3 3/4" Basic White Writing layer above the score line on the insert.
- Add double sided tape to the inside right and left edges of the bottom flap of the cardstock insert. See 3rd photo above.

Pop Up Gift Card Holder



Paper Cutting Dimensions

- Cut the cardstock card base 4 1/4" x 10". I used Cherry Cobbler cardstock.
- Score the card base on the long side at 1 1/4", 3 3/4", 5 3/4", and 7 3/4".
- Hold the card base with the 1 1/4" scored panel on the left. Fold the third score line back.
- Using a circle die or punch cut a circle in the middle of the folded panel.
- Add double sided tape to close the pop up as shown below.
- Put the card holder edge into the paper trimmer as shown and cut ¼" from the top of the pop up.



- Cut patterned paper pieces as follows: Two at 2" x 4", Two at 1" x4", One at 2 1/4" x 4".
- Cut a Basic White layer at 4" x 2 3/4". This is the writing layer.
- Adhere the patterned paper layers to the matching panels.
- I used 3 small Velcro dot to close this gift card holder or you can create a belly band.
- Decorate the front with coordinating elements.



Folded Gift Card Holder With Belly Band

Paper Cutting Dimensions

- Cut cardstock base 4 1/4" x 8".
- Score at 2 1/2" and 6".
- Use a punch or circle die to cut a tab on the 2 1/2" end flap.
- Cut three patterned paper layers: One 4" x 2 ¼" for the front top flap, the second 4" x 1 ¼" for the inside tab panel, and the third 4" x 3 ¼", for the back.
- Cut a 4" x 2 1/4" Basic White cardstock layer for the top inside writing layer.
- Cut a 1" x 8" cardstock strip for the Belly Band.



- With your circle punch or die, cut a circle tab on the end of the card base as shown.
- Cut a curcle tab on the 1 1/4" x 4" patterned paper layer. (for the card holder tab section).
- Add adhesive to the inside of the tab flap as shown above.
- Fold the tab flap to the center of the card base and secure.
- Adhere the patterned paper layers to the card base.
- Assemble the Belly Band as shown above.
- Wrap my Belly Bands around the card base with the seam in the front, making sure each end is even. Then glue together.
- Decorate the front of the Belly Band with die cut elements.
