The supplies I used for this project are listed at the end of this Tutorial. You can substitute with what you have on hand. It's fun to go through our paper crafting stash to create something new.

Tags:

- The tags are die cut using Very Vanilla cardstock and a die from the Celebrations Tags Bundle.
- I stamped the snowflake (from the Christmas Lights stamp set) off once using Cherry Cobbler, Soft Succulent and Crumb Cake ink.
- The pine bough (from the Christmas Banners stamp set) is stamped off once using Mossy Meadow ink.
- I die cut the snowflakes and bows using dies from the Celebration Tags and Cottage Wreath Dies.

The Gift Box:

- Cut the bottom of the box using Thick Basic White cardstock at 4 3/4" x 4".
- Score the box bottom 3/4" on each side. Burnish your score lines.
- Cut small tabs on the longer side of the box bottom as shown below.



- Add Tear & Tape or glue to each tab.
- Fold the tab in and attach to the sides of the box.

The Box Top:

- Cut a piece of patterned paper 4 7/8" x 4 1/8" and score 3/4" in on each side.
- Cut tabs and add adhesive to each of the four corner tabs.
- The top of the box is identical to the bottom except for the cutting dimensions. The top is slightly larger.

The Belly Band:

- Cut a coordinating cardstock strip 1" x 9".
- Gently fold the cardstock strip horizontally around the box, creasing the edges lightly.
- The belly band will meet on the front of the box. The seam will be at the top of the box.
- Remove the belly band with the creases from the box and press the creases.
- Place the belly band around the box again and glue the ends together.

The Sentiment Topper:



- I used one of the scalloped dies and gold Glimmer Paper to die cut a layer for the sentiment label.

- The dimensions for the gold Glimmer Paper layer are 2 1/2" x 3".
- The sentiment label is die cut using a die from the Brightest Glow Bundle and Very Vanilla cardstock.
- I stamped the sentiment (from the Brightest Glow Bundle) with Evening Evergreen and Cherry Cobbler ink, depending on what patterned paper I used.






