## ***Dimensions***

White 12x12 and 8-1/2 x 11

- 9 1/2" x 10" - 2 of these  
On 9 1/2" side score at 5 1/4"  
On 10" side score at 4 1/2" and 9"
- 4 3/8" x 4 3/8" you need 3 of these - one for the lid, the bottom of the box and the inside of the box to add support

Poppy Parade

- 6-5/8" x 6 5/8" this is for the top -  
score at 1" on all sides
- 4-1/8" x 4-1/8" also for the lid of the box
- scrap for die cut

old olive

- scrap for die cut

black

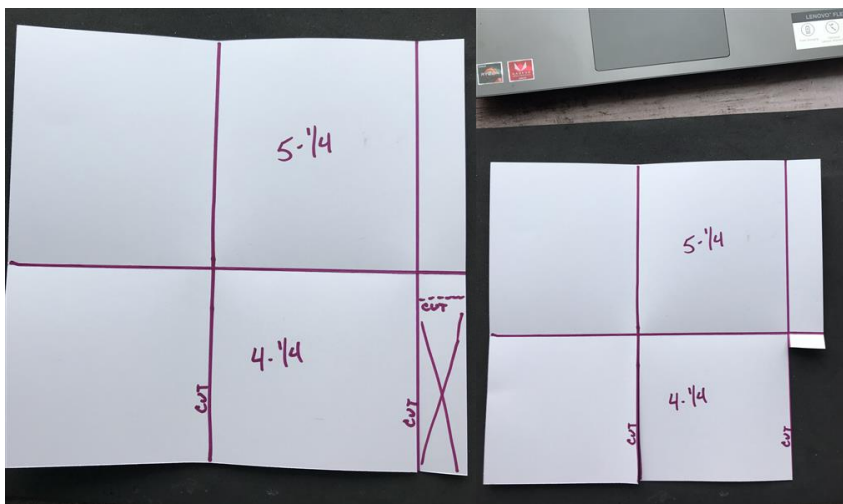

- 4 at 4 1/4" x 5" - 4 of these

## ***Step by Step***

For the box base

1. after cutting and scoring all of your cardstock, fold and burnish all score lines.
2. cut up the 2 score lines on the short side. leave a 1/2 inch flap on the narrow piece and remove the rest. repeat on the other piece



3. flip both over and use tear and tape on the narrow flaps
4. adhere together to make the box sides

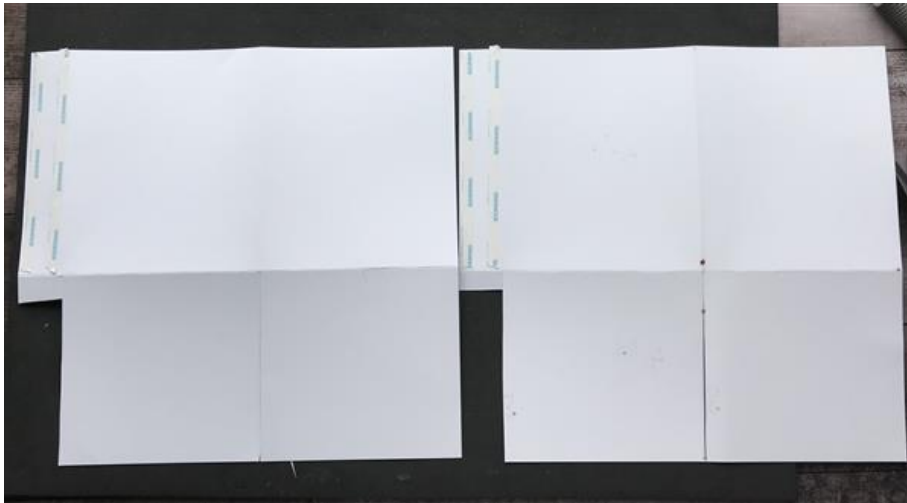

5. fold all four bottom flaps in without tape to determine where the tape should go. unfold three flaps and adhere tear tape to the inside. remove the backing and put box bottom together. make sure to keep the box square. push your hand down on the inside to secure the flaps
6. with tear tape add the cardstock piece to the outside of the bottom. This will cover the entire bottom and make it uniform. Do the same for the inside.
7. layer the vellum on the cardstock pieces then adhere them to the box. it should be as close to the bottom of the box as possible. If there is any gap at the top, it will be covered by the lid
8. insert your tissue box. It should fit snugly.



## Embellishments

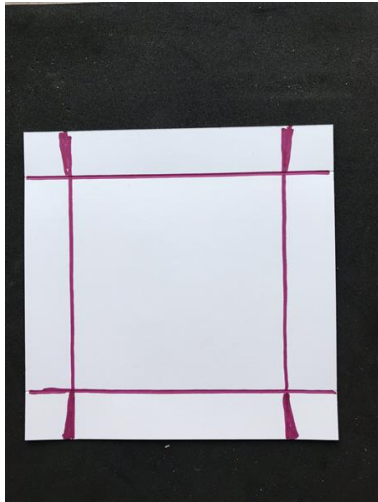
1. use Poppy Moments die set to cut poppy base using poppy parade, poppy and leaf detail with basic black, and old olive for leaf base,.
2. stamp leaf from Painted poppies with black ink on old olive. Cut out with Painted labels die
3. adhere all to tissue box with snail or liquid glue.

## Lid

1. fold and burnish on all score lines. cut up each of the four corners and notch the flaps

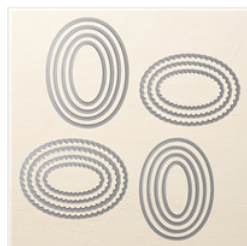


2. adhere to the poppy parade square piece for the lid onto one of the 4-3/8 x 4-3/8 white pieces. Use the second largest Oval die to cut out both pieces at once with die cutting machine.
3. layer these on the Poppy Parade lid. Do not attach it. Use a pencil to mark the oval on the poppy parade lid. Using the big shot to cut the second largest oval die from the lid. You will need to fold in the sides of the box lid in order to fit in the bigshot but it won't cut the sides.
4. adhere to the layers onto the box lid. complete the box lid by adhering the flaps with tear tape

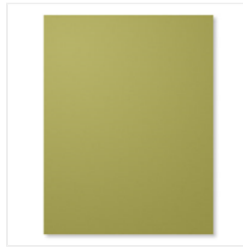

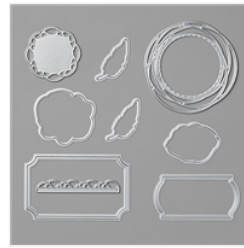
