

Project Sheet - Dec 15 2023



This card was created using the *Hooray for Surprises Stamp Set* and paper from the *Bee Mine 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper* pack. This card is quick and easy to create. While the coordinating dies for this stamp set are fun...I went with just using the stamp set today! I was thinking about creating a gift card holder that was actually part of the inside panel, so I sat down with some copy paper and fiddled with measurements, and this is what I came up with! I'm not sure if anyone else has come up with this design, this is just what popped into my head at the time. Let's take a look at the card!

### Supplies:

- Hooray for Surprises Stamp Set (Item #162851)
- Bee Mine 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper (Item #162546)
- Adhesive Backed Hearts & Flowers (Item #162557)
- Ribbon Duo Combo Pack
- 2-3/8" Circle Punch
- Cardstock: Basic White, Petal Pink, Sweet Sorbet
- Ink: Petal Pink, Sweet Sorbet, Daffodil Delight

#### 1. Card Cuts:

- Card Base Cut 1 Petal Pink cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2". Score at 4-1/4"
- DSP Panel Cut 1 Sweet Sorbet floral paper from the Bee Mine DSP to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Scrap of Basic White for punching out 2-3/8" circle

- Inside Mat Cut 1 Sweet Sorbet cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Inside Panel/Gift Card Holder Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 8" x 5-1/4". Score at 4" and 6". The 4" score line is a valley fold and the 6" score line is a mountain fold.
- DSP Strip for front of Gift Card Holder Cut 1 coordinating designer series paper to 5-1/8" x 1-3/4"
- Envelope Flap Cut 1 piece of coordinating designer series paper to 6" x 2-1/4"
- 2. Adhere the 5-3/8" x 4-1/8" designer series paper panel to the card front.
- 3. Using a 2-3/8" Circle Punch, punch 1 circle from Basic White cardstock. Using the stamps from the Hooray For Surprises Stamp set, stamp the following onto the circle:
  - Stamp the birthday cake towards the bottom of the white circle in Petal Pink ink.
  - Stamp the candle on top of the cake in Sweet Sorbet ink.
  - Stamp the candle flame above the candle in Daffodil Delight ink.
  - Stamp the sentiment "Make a Wish" in Sweet Sorbet ink over top of the birthday cake.
  - Stamp several hearts in Petal Pink ink around and to the sides of the candle.
  - Stamp Several flowers in Sweet Sorbet ink around and to the sides of the candle.




- 1. Adhere the stamped circle to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals. Center the circle from top to bottom and left to right.
- 2. Create the inside panel/gift card holder as follows from the 8" x 5-1/4" piece of white cardstock:
  - Fold the 4" score line as a valley fold and fold the 6" score line as a mountain fold.




When complete, the gift card holder will sit at the bottom of the inside panel and will fold up and down.

· Read through all directions on this step first!



 Apply Tear & Tape Along these edges to adhere the 2" x 5-1/4" sections together.



- 2. Use a Paper Trimmer to trim off just the creased edge to create a pocket.
- 3. Use a Circle Punch to punch out a ¼ of a circle along the cut edge.

Important: Before using a circle punch to punch out a 1/4" of a circle at the top edge of the gift card holder, be sure to adhere the 5-1/8" x 1-3/4" piece of coordinating designer series paper to the front of the gift card holder section!






- 6. Once you have created the gift card holder section for the card, stamp the sentiment "Hope your Birthday is wonderful" in Sweet Sorbet ink onto the inside panel portion. Then stamp the small heart image on the left and right of the sentiment in Petal Pink ink. Adhere the combination inside panel/gift card holder to a Sweet Sorbet mat, then adhere to the inside of the card. The gift card holder portion of this panel will sit along the bottom edge of the inside of the card base.
- 7. On the envelope front, stamp small hearts in Petal Pink, then stamp several small flowers in Sweet Sorbet ink.
- 8. Adhere the piece of coordinating designer series paper to the envelope flap and use a small pair of scissors or paper snips to trim the excess paper away from the flap.
- 9. Tie a bow using Petal Pink ribbon from the Ribbon Duo Combo Pack and adhere the bow to the card front using a Mini Glue Dot. Position the bow to the upper left of the circle.
- 10. Adhere a flower and heart to the circle on the card front using the Adhesive Backed Hearts & Flowers embellishments.
