This pretty little birthday card was created with the fun Pocket Thoughts Bundle. The Pocket Thoughts Dies includes three different sized dies to cut out pockets and two of the dies are perfect for holding gift cards! Let's take a look!

Supplies:

- Pocket Thoughts Bundle
- Stylish Shapes Dies
- Lily Pond Lane 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper
- Silver & White Sheer Ribbon
- Adhesive-Backed Dappled Dots
- Cardstock: Gray Granite, Pretty in Pink, Basic White
- Ink: Tuxedo Black Memento Ink, Pretty in Pink, Petunia Pop
- Stampin' Blends: Pretty in Pink, Melon Mambo, Petunia Pop, Gray Granite

1. Card Cuts:

- Card Base - Cut 1 Gray Granite cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"
- Outside & Inside Mats - Cut 2 Pretty in Pink cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- DSP Panel - Cut 1 Gray Granite print from the Lily Pond Lane Designer Series Paper to 5" x 3-3/4"

- DSP Pocket Die Cut - Cut 1 white and Pretty in Pink print from the Lily Pond Lane Designer Series Paper to 4" x 3-1/4"
 - Pull Out Panel - Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 3-5/8" x 2-1/4"
 - Circle Die Cut - Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to approximately 2-3/4" x 2-3/4"
 - Inside Panel - Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 5" x 3-3/4"
 - Envelope Flap - Cut 1 coordinating piece of designer series paper to 6" x 2-1/4"
2. On the Gray Granite DSP Panel measuring 5" x 3-3/4" use the small heart stamp and stamp hearts around the perimeter of the panel in Gray Granite ink. Adhere this panel to one of the Pretty in Pink mats, then adhere this to the card front.
 3. Use the medium Pocket Thoughts pocket die to cut out a pocket from the white and pink check print measuring 4" x 3-1/4". Gently burnish the scorelines created by the die, then adhere the pocket to the card front. The bottom edge of the pocket sits approximately 3/4" from the bottom edge of the card base.
 4. On a scrap piece of white cardstock measuring approximately 2-3/4" x 2-3/4", stamp the cupcake image using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Use Petunia Pop Stampin' Blends to color the cupcake wrapper. Use Pretty in Pink and Petunia Pop Stampin' Blends to color in the cupcake icing. Use a Gray Granite Stampin' Blend to draw in a surface at the bottom of the cupcake. Use the Second from largest circle die from the Stylish Shapes Dies to cut out the image. Adhere the die cut circle image to the front of the pocket using Stampin' Dimensionals. making sure not to obstruct the thumb opening on the pocket.

5. On the white Pull Out Panel, use a single hole punch to punch a hole at the top center of the panel. Stamp the small arrow in Petunia Pop ink just below the punched single hole. Towards the center of the panel, stamp the sentiment "Yay for You!" in Petunia Pop ink, then stamp hearts on either side of the sentiment in Pretty in Pink ink. Cut a short length of Silver & White Sheer Ribbon and loop it through the hole punch and trim as necessary. Insert the Pull Out Panel into the pocket on the card front.

6. On the inside panel, stamp the "happy birthday" sentiment in Petunia Pop ink. Then stamp hearts around the sentiment in Pretty in Pink ink. Adhere the panel to the remaining Pretty in Pink mat, then adhere this to the inside of the card.

7. Stamp hearts onto the lower corner of the envelope front in Pretty in Pink.
8. Adhere the coordinating piece of designer series paper to the envelope flap and use a small pair of scissors or paper snips to trim the excess paper away from the flap.
9. Tie a small bow from Silver & White Sheer Ribbon and adhere the bow towards the bottom of the cupcake on the card front using a Mini Glue Dot.
10. Adhere a single pink Adhesive-Backed Dappled Dot at the top of the cupcake to complete the card.
