
Make these adorable treat pouches using the supplies you have on hand! I offer two different sizes here. The smaller treat pouch measures 1" x 4" and the larger pouch measures 1-1/2" x 4". These fun little treat pouches work up quickly and are great as stocking stuffers, treats for friends, family or coworkers, small gifts for teachers, pet groomers, or even table favors! Fill them with your favorite convection! I provide the basic instructions below.


Here are the basics for the larger treat pouch:

- 1. Cut cardstock to 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" and score at 1" on all sides.
- 2. Designer Series Paper Cut 1 piece of designer series paper to 4" x 6-3/4"

- 1) Cut cardstock to 3-1/2" x 3-1/2". Score at 1" on all sides.
- 2) Cut a wedge from each corner up to the 1" score line. Apply Tear & Tape to each corner tab.
- 3) Adhere each corner tab to the sides, forming a box.

- Apply two strips of Tear & Tape around the box sides and a one strip of Tear & Tape along one of the 4" sides of the designer series paper.
- Adhere the un-taped edge of the designer series paper to the middle of one of the sides of the box. Continue wrapping designer series paper to the box sides.
- 3) Remove Tear & Tape cover from designer series paper and adhere the remaining paper to itself to form the pouch.

- 1) Pinch the top of the pouch on either side.
- 2) Use a single hole punch to punch a hole at the top center of the pouch.
- 3) Insert a length of ribbon through the punched holes and tie a ribbon.
- 4) Decorate as desired!


Here are the basics for the small treat pouch:

- 1. Cut cardstock to 3-1/4" x 3-1/4" and score at 1" on all sides.
- 2. Designer Series Paper Cut 1 piece of designer series paper to 4" x 6"
- 3. Follow the same directions as shown above for the larger treat pouch.
