

I used the beautiful **Seaside Wishes Bundle** to create today's card. This bundle includes a hybrid embossing folder, but I chose not to use the embossing folder on this particular card. Instead of using designer series paper for the background on the card front I used the sea glass stamps in the **Seaside Wishes Stamp Set** to create a pretty background to highlight the pretty sand dollars and starfish. Let's take a closer look!

Supplies:

- Seaside Wishes Bundle (Item #163498)
- Peach Pie Bordered Ribbon (Item #163783)
- 2024-2026 In Color Resin Dots (Item #163389)
- Cardstock: Summer Splash (Item #163797), Pool Party, Calypso Coral, Basic White
- Ink: Smoky Slate, Calypso Coral, Peach Pie (Item #163810), Summer Splash (Item #163809), Balmy Blue, Pool Party

1. Card Cuts:

Card Base - Cut 1 Summer Splash cardstock to 11" x 4-1/4", score at 5-1/2"

- Outside & Inside Mats Cut 2 Calypso Coral cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Outside Panel Cut 1 Pool Party cardstock to 5-1/4" x 4"
- · Scraps of Basic White cardstock for stamping and die cutting sand dollars and starfish
- Scraps of Summer Splash cardstock for die cutting sea grasses
- Inside Panel Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 5-1/4" x 4"

2. Prepare the Outside Panel:

- On the Outside Panel of Pool Party cardstock, first and second generation stamp the
 three sea glass images in Pool Party, Summer Splash and Balmy Blue inks. Space
 these images out so that they evenly cover the panel. Use the dotted stamp to second
 generation stamp dots in between the sea glass images using Smoky Slate ink. In
 some cases the images overlap and this provides a little depth.
- Adhere the stamped panel to one of the Calypso Coral mats.
- Use a length of Peach Pie Bordered Ribbon around the assembled panels horizontally. I positioned the bottom edge of the ribbon approximately 2" from the bottom of the panel unit. Secure the end of the ribbon onto the back of the panel using a small amount of Stampin' Seal. Adhere this panel unit to the card front using liquid glue.

3. Prepare the die cut pieces for the card:

- On scrap pieces of Basic White cardstock second generation stamp one large and one small sand dollar using Smoky Slate ink. Use the coordinating Seaside Wishes Dies to cut out the images. Note: The sea dollar die cuts out three sand dollars at one time. You will need to line up this die with each of your stamped images. I cut the two sand dollars out individually.
- Cut out one small detailed (cut out) sand dollar from Basic White cardstock.
- Cut out the three sea grass images from Summer Splash cardstock.
- Stamp two small star fish in Calypso Coral ink and use the coordinating die to cut out the images.
- Stamp one large star fish in Peach Pie ink and use the coordinating die to cut out the image.

- 4. Arrange the die cut pieces onto the card front. Partially adhere the large star fish to the small sand dollar using liquid glue. Then adhere the large sand dollar to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals. The detailed cut out sand dollar should be partially adhered to the large sand dollar on the right, then adhere the small sand dollar and star fish unit to the other two sand dollars using a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the sea grasses just above the sand dollars on the right and tuck in the two small star fish slightly under the sand dollars. Refer to photos for placement. Note: I opted not to use a sentiment on the card front.
- 5. On the inside panel stamp the sentiment "Sometimes the simplest things mean the most" in Summer Splash ink. On the lower left corner of the panel, stamp a large star fish in Peach Pie ink then stamp several small star fish in Calypso Coral ink. Use the dotted stamp to stamp dots around the star fish using Smoky Slate ink. Adhere the panel to the remaining Calypso Coral mat, then adhere the unit to the inside of the card.

- 6. Repeat partial stamping of the large and small star fish and dots onto the envelope front using the same colors as you did for the inside panel.
- 7. Stamp a single small star fish onto the envelope flap in Calypso Coral ink.
- 8. Adhere several Peach Pie and Summer Splash 2024-2026 In Color Resin Dots to the card front to complete the project.
