Need a quick card to drop in the mail to a friend or loved one? I used the **Wanted to Say Dies** to make this card up in a matter of minutes. The cheerful paper is from the **Full of Life 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper** Pack. There is no stamping on this card...just a little die cutting. Let's take a look!

Supplies:

- Wanted to Say Dies
- Full of Life 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper
- Baker's Twine Three Color Pack
- Opal Rounds Assortment
- Adhesive Sheets
- Cardstock: Crushed Curry, Basic White

1. Card Cuts:

- Card Base - Cut 1 Crushed Curry cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"
- Mat - Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"

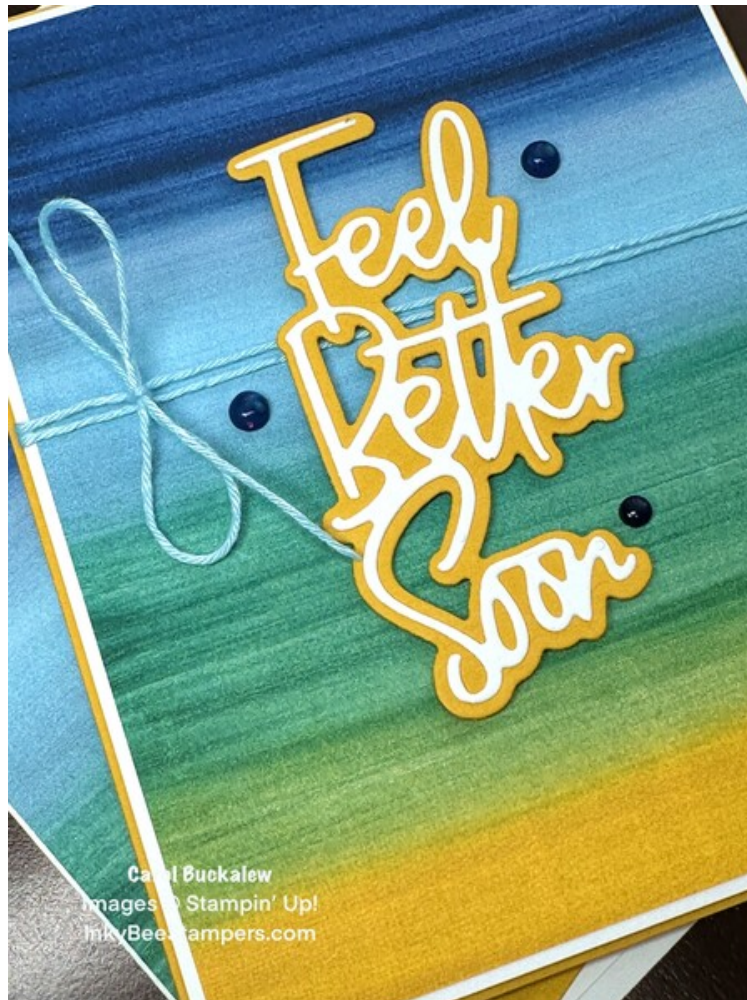

- DSP Panel - Cut 1 multicolored paper from the Full of Life Designer Series Paper pack to 5-1/4" x 4"
 - Sentiment - Scraps of Crushed Curry and Basic White that measure approximately 3-1/4" x 2" each
 - Inside Panel - Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
 - DSP Strip - Cut 1 coordinating designer series paper strip measuring 5-1/4" x 1/2"
 - Envelope Flap - Cut 1 coordinating piece of designer series paper to 6" x 2-1/4"
2. Adhere the DSP Panel to the white mat and wrap a length of blue Baker's Twine around the upper third of the unit two times and tie a small bow to the left of the panel. Then adhere the panel unit to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
 3. Use the Wanted to Say Dies to cut out the background of the "Feel Better Soon" sentiment from Crushed Curry cardstock.



4. Use the Wanted to Say Dies to cut out the detailed "Feel Better Soon" sentiment from white cardstock. Before running the die through your die cutting machine, adhere a piece of Adhesive Sheet to the back of your cardstock. This will make adhering the detailed

sentiment cut out to its background easier. Adhere the detailed die cut sentiment to its die cut background piece, then adhere the sentiment to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.

5. Adhere the 1/4" designer series paper strip to the right side of the Inside Panel then adhere the panel to the inside of the card.



6. Adhere three blue Opal Rounds around the die cut sentiment on the card front.
7. Adhere the coordinating piece of designer series paper to the envelope flap and trim the excess paper away from the flap using a pair of scissors or paper snips.

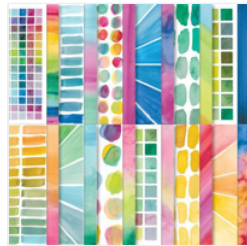

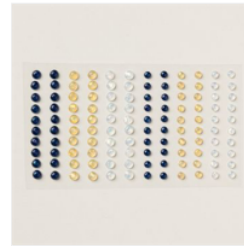
