Today's card was created using the adorable *Potions & Spells Bundle*, *Bright & Beautiful 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper*, and a little bit of the *Country Woods 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper*. This was such a fun card to pull together!

#### Supplies:

- Potions & Spells Bundle
- Bright & Beautiful 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper
- Country Woods 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper
- Adhesive-Backed Shiny Sequins
- · Wink of Stella
- Cardstock: Basic White, Early Espresso, Granny Apple Green, Crumb Cake
- Ink: Tuxedo Black Memento Ink, Early Espresso, Granny Apple Green
- Stampin' Blends: Lemon Lime Twist, Pebbled Path, Crumb Cake, Daffodil Delight, Boho Blue, Granny Apple Green
- 1. Card Cuts:

- Card Base Cut 1 Early Espresso cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"
- Mats Cut 2 Granny Apple Green cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- DSP Panel Cut 1 Bright & Beautiful Designer Series Paper in Lemon Lime Twist print to 5-1/4" x 4"
- Die Cut Components on Card Front:

Cauldron - Scrap of Early Espresso cardstock

Cauldron Rim - Scrap of woodgrain print from Country Woods Designer Series Paper

Bookshelves - Cut 3 strips of woodgrain print from Country Woods Designer Series Paper to 1/2" x 3"

Crow and Books - Scrap of Basic White cardstock

Bottles - Scraps of Early Espresso and Crumb Cake

Bottle Fill - Scraps of Bright & Beautiful Designer Series Paper

Bubbles - Scraps of Lemon Lime Twist print from Bright & Beautiful Designer Series Paper

- Inside Panel Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 5-1/4" x 4"
- Envelope Flap Cut 1 coordinating piece of designer series paper to 6" x 2-1/4"
- 2. Using the Potions & Spells Dies, partially cut the top of the cauldron from Early Espresso cardstock. I cut the top 5/8" of the cauldron. Die cut just the rim of the cauldron from a woodgrain print from the Country Woods Designer Series Paper. Before adhering the top of the cauldron to the lower right of the DSP Panel, use the Potions & Spells Stamp Set to stamp the bubbles image in Granny Apple Green ink just above where the top of the cauldron will sit. Then adhere the Early Espresso partial cauldron die cut to the bottom right of the Lemon Lime Twist designer series paper panel. Make sure that the bottom of the die cut is flush with the bottom of the DSP panel.
- 3. On the Lemon Lime Twist DSP Panel, stamp the "Double, Double, Toil & Trouble" sentiment in the upper right corner of the panel in Early Espresso ink. Then use the small multi star image from the Potions & Spells Stamp Set randomly across the panel in Granny Apple Green ink. I stamped this image four times.
- 4. Die cut 2 round potion bottles and 1 rectangular bottle from Early Espresso cardstock. Partially cut just the tops of the bottles from scraps of Crumb Cake cardstock then use a pair of scissors or snips to cut just the tops of the bottles and adhere the Crumb Cake tops to the full image bottles using a small amount of liquid glue. Die cut the fills for the bottles from scraps of the Bright & Beautiful Designer Series Paper and adhere the "fills" to the bottles.

- 5. On a scrap piece of white cardstock, stamp the crow and stack of books using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color the images as follows then die cut:
  - Color the crow's body using Pebbled Path Stampin' Blends then color the beak and feet using Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends.
  - Color the stack of books using Lemon Lime Twist, and Boho Blue Stampin' Blends. Then color the pages using Crumb Cake Stampin' Blends.
- 6. Die cut 4 bubbles from Lemon Lime Twist print from the Bright & Beautiful Designer Series Paper. I cut 2 small sized bubbles, 1 medium sized bubble and 1 large bubble. Use the dark shade of a Granny Apple Green Stampin' Blend to darken just the edges of the bubbles.
- 7. Arrange the 3 1/2" wood grain "shelf" strips onto the DSP Panel. Do not adhere yet! The bottom bookshelf comes in from the left, the middle bookshelf comes in from the right and the top bookshelf comes in from the left. Lay the die cut crow, bottles and books on top of the "shelves" to get an idea of placement. You just want to make sure that everything fits before adhering the "shelves" down with liquid glue. Once satisfied with the placement of the shelves, adhere them to the DSP panel using liquid glue. Use a pair of paper snips to

trim the strips flush with the edges of the DSP Panel.


- 8. Adhere the crow, bottles and books to the tops of their shelves using liquid glue. Refer to photos for reference. Adhere the wood grain cauldron rim to the top of the cauldron using Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the four bubbles to the DSP Panel using Stampin' Dimensionals. Use Wink of Stella on the bubbles and bottle "fills" (not the entire bottle). Also use Wink of Stella on the stamped bubbles just above the cauldron. Use a white gel pen to draw in highlights on the stamped bubbles if desired.
- 9. Adhere the DSP Panel to one of the Granny Apple Green mats, then adhere this to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 10. Stamp the "Happy Halloween" sentiment onto the Inside Panel in Early Espresso ink. Stamp the bubble image onto the lower right corner of the panel in Granny Apple Green ink. Stamp the multi-star image around the panel several times in Granny Apple Green ink. Use Wink of Stella on the stamped bubbles and stars to add a little sparkle. Use a white gel pen to draw in highlights on the bubbles if desired. Adhere the panel to the remaining Granny Apple Green mat, then adhere this to the inside of the card.

- 11. Repeat stamping of the bubbles and multi-star images onto the envelope front in Granny Apple Green ink. Apply Wink of Stella on the bubbles and stars.
- 12. Adhere the coordinating piece of designer series paper to the envelope flap and use a small pair of scissors or paper snips to trim the excess paper away from the flap.
- 13. Adhere multiple green Adhesive-Backed Shiny Sequins to the card front.
