I have a very simple project for you today...a quick and easy treat box using the **Square Pillow Boxes**, **Artistic Mix Decorative Masks**, and the **Excellent Eggs Dies**! This project is also a great cardstock scrap buster, too!

Supplies:

- Square Pillow Boxes
- Artistic Mix Decorative Masks
- Excellent Eggs Dies
- Silver & White Sheer Ribbon
- Purple Fine Shimmer Gems
- Cardstock: Gorgeous Grape, Fresh Freesia, Basic White, Berry Burst, Daffodil Delight
- Ink: Highland Heather
- Blending Brush

1. Cardstock Cuts:

- Cut 1 Gorgeous Grape cardstock to approximately 3" x 2-1/2". Use the second from largest egg die from the Excellent Eggs Dies set to cut out.
- Cut the following cardstock strips to 3-1/2" x 3/4", then cut out zig zag pieces from each strip using the zig zag die from the Excellent Eggs Dies set:

Cut 1 Daffodil Delight strip

Cut 1 Berry Burst strip

Cut 1 Basic White strip

Cut 1 Fresh Freesia strip


- 2. Adhere the zig zag strips to the Gorgeous Grape egg. Use a pair of paper snips to trim the strips flush with the edges of the egg.
- 3. Lay one unassembled Square Pillow Box onto a protected work surface. Lay the decorative mask of your choice over the Square Pillow Box so that the mask is covering the top third of the Pillow Box. Secure the corners of the mask to your work surface using Post It Notes or Post It Tape. Use a Blending Brush to blend Highland Heather ink over the Square Pillow Box. Reposition the mask to ink blend the middle third and lower third of the box. Allow the ink to dry.



- 4. Assemble the Square Pillow Box by carefully folding along the scored, curved edges of the box. Remove the tape covers and secure the sides of the box together.
- 5. Use a length of Silver & White Sheer Ribbon and wrap the ribbon around the box vertically and tie a bow. I positioned the bow so that it would site on the left side of the box.



- 6. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the decorated egg to the box front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 7. Decorate the egg with embellishments of your choice! I used Purple Fine Shimmer Gems on my egg.
- 8. Fill the Square Pillow Box with a treat of your choice!
