

Today's card was created using the *Market Goodness Bundle* and the *To Market 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper*. I used this bundle to create a fun thank you card with a basket full of veggies fresh from the market! For the card front, the veggies were die cut from the designer series paper and I fussy cut the basket and flower bouquet from the designer series paper. This card comes together quickly. Let's get started!

#### Supplies:

- Market Goodness Bundle
- Spotlight On Nature Dies
- To Market 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper
- Transparent Adhesive-Backed Dots
- Large Check Ribbon
- Cardstock: Crumb Cake, Blackberry Bliss, Garden Green, Basic White
- Ink: Blackberry Bliss, Pumpkin Pie, Garden Green
- 1. Card Cuts:

- Card Base Cut 1 Crumb Cake cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"
- DSP Panel #1 Cut 1 Blackberry Bliss plaid print from the To Market DSP to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Square Mat Cut 1 Blackberry Bliss cardstock to 3-3/4" x 3-3/4"
- DSP Panel #2 Cut 1 woodgrain print from the To Market DSP to 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"
- Sentiment Label Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to approximately 1-3/4" x 1-3/4"
- Sentiment Label Mat Cut 1 Garden Green Cardstock to approximately 2-1/4" x 2-1/4"
- Die Cut Veggies From the To Market DSP, die cut 1 lettuce, 1 bunch of tomatoes, 1 turnip, 1 radish and 1 bunch of carrots
- Fussy Cut Basket & Flowers From the To Market DSP, fussy cut 1 basket and 1 bunch of flowers
- Inside Panel Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 5-1/4" x 4"
- Inside Panel Mat Cut 1 Blackberry Bliss cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Envelope Flap Cut 1 coordinating piece of designer series paper to 6" x 2-1/4"
- 2. Adhere the 5-3/8" x 4-1/8" plaid DSP Panel #1 to the card front.
- 3. Adhere the square woodgrain DSP Panel #2 to its Blackberry Bliss mat. Adhere this unit to the top of the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals. Be sure to leave an equal reveal around the left, top and right edge of the panel unit.
- 4. Use the Market Goodness Dies to cut out the vegetables from one of the papers from the To Market Designer Series Paper pack. From the same paper pack, fussy cut 1 basket and 1 bouquet of flowers (pick your favorite color of flowers!).
- 5. Adhere the fussy cut basket to the square panel on the card front using liquid glue. Place the glue only on the left, bottom and right edges of the back of the basket so you're able to tuck the vegetables into the basket. Position the basket towards the bottom of the square panel so the bottom of the basket is approximately a 1/2" from the bottom of the panel and center from left to right.

- 6. Arrange the vegetables into the basket and when you're pleased with the arrangement, begin gluing the vegetables into the basket. Adhere the fussy cut bouquet of flowers across the right side of the basket at an angle.
- 7. Use the Spotlight on Nature Dies to die cut a white sentiment label and a Garden Green mat. I used the smallest circle die with the flower edge for the sentiment label and the next size up for the mat. Using the Market Goodness Stamp Set, stamp the sentiment "For you" in Blackberry Bliss ink onto the white sentiment label then adhere the label to the Garden Green mat. Adhere the sentiment label to the lower left of the square panel on the card front using a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals. Refer to photos for placement.
- 8. On the inside panel stamp the sentiment "thanks a bunch" in Blackberry Bliss ink. On the lower corner of the panel, stamp the carrots in Pumpkin Pie ink and a turnip in Blackberry Bliss ink. Stamp the vegetable tops in Garden Green ink. Adhere the panel to its Blackberry Bliss mat, then adhere this to the inside of the card.

- 9. Repeat stamping of the carrots and turnip onto the envelope front and stamp the vegetable tops in Garden Green ink.
- 10. Adhere the coordinating piece of designer series paper to the envelope flap and use a small pair of scissors or paper snips to trim the excess paper away from the flap.
- 11. Tie a bow from the Large Check Ribbon and adhere the bow across the stems of the flower bouquet on the card front using a Mini Glue Dot.
- 12. Adhere several of the Transparent Adhesive-Backed Dots to the card front to complete the project.
