- 1. Card Cuts:
 - Cut 1 Garden Green cardstock to 11" x 4-1/4", score at 4-1/4" and 5-1/2"
 - Mats

Cut 1 Copper Clay cardstock to 4-1/8" x 1-1/8"

Cut 1 Copper Clay cardstock to 4-1/8" x 4-1/8"

DSP Panels

Cut 1 Crushed Curry and white stripe print to 4" x 1"

Cut 1 Bubble Bath and Daisies print to 4" x 4"

- Scraps of Basic White and Garden Green cardstocks for die cutting or stamping and die cutting
- Inside Mat Cut 1 Copper Clay cardstock to 4-1/8" x 4-1/8"
- Inside Panel Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 4" x 4"
- Envelope Flap Cut 1 coordinating DSP to 6" x 2-1/2"
- 2. For the card front, adhere the DSP Panels to their Copper Clay mats then adhere the panels to the card front.
- 3. Adhere a piece of Copper Clay Textured Ribbon vertically over the book binding portion of the card. Secure the ends to the inside of the book binding using Tear & Tape. Glue the 1-1/4" book binding section together from the inside of the card.
- 4. Prepare Flower Components:
 - On a scrap piece of Basic White cardstock, second-generation stamp the small daisy using Pebbled Path ink.
 - On a scrap of Basic White cardstock stamp the sentimet "Wishing you the brightest birthday" in Crushed Cury ink.
 - Use the outline of the small Daisy to die cut the stamped Daisy.
 - Use the label die to cut out the sentiment label.
 - From an additional scrap of white card stock, cut out the embossed small Daisy.
 Adhere the detailed Daisy to the stamped Daisy.
 - Stamp 1 small flower center onto Basic White cardstock using Crushed Curry ink, then fussy cut the Daisy center.
 - Use the light shade of a Bubble Bath Stampin' Blend to color just the tips of the outer daisy and the centers of the inner daisy.
 - Onto a piece of Garden Green cardstock, stamp 3 leaves and 1 stem. Use the coordinating dies to cut out.
 - Onto a scrap piece of Copper Clay cardstock, die cut 1 branch image.
- 5. Adhere the Copper Clay branch to the Bubble Bath panel on the card front using liquid glue. Position the bottom of the branch at the base of the printed Daisy stems on the DSP panel. Adhere the Daisy stem to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals. You will need to cut very thin strips of Dimensionals. Adhere the Daisy to the top of the stem using Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the Daisy center to the center of the Daisy using Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the leaves using liquid glue and tuck the base of the leaves slightly

under the flower stem.



- 6. Adhere the sentiment label to the bottom center of the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 7. Tie a knot from a short length of Copper Clay Textured Ribbon. Adhere the knot to the strip of previously adhered ribbon using a Mini Glue Dot.
- 8. On the inside panel, second generation stamp the small Daisy using Pebbled Path ink. Stamp the Daisy image again onto a Post It Note and fussy cut around several of the lower petals to create a mask. Apply the mask over the stamped Daisy on the inside panel, then stamp the Daisy stem using Garden Green ink. Remove the mask and stamp a leaf on each side of the stem using Garden Green ink. Stamp the center of the Daisy using Crushed Curry ink. Use the light shade of a Bubble Bath Stampin' Blend to color just the tips of the flower petals and the center of the flower petals. Repeat this process to stamp a Daisy on the lower left of the envelope front.

- 9. Adhere the inside panel to its Copper Clay mat, then adhere this unit to the inside of the card.
- 10. Adhere several 2023-2024 In Color Dots to the card front.
- 11. Adhere a piece of coordinating designer series paper to the envelope flap and trim the excess paper away from the flap.
