1. Start with an 8 1/2 x 5 1/2 sheet of Whisper White cardstock. Fold in half.
2. Cut two strips of Designer Series Paper (DSP) from the Wildflower Fields Designer Series Paper packet, measuring 3/4 " by 4 3/4"
3. Attach DSP to card front.
4. Using Basic Black Archival ink pad, stamp the flower images onto a piece of white cardstock measuring 2 7/8" square. Stamp "sweet" onto lower right corner.
5. Use aquapainters and ink pads to color images.
6. Layer this piece onto a 3 inch square piece of Lost Lagoon cardstock.
7. On a small piece of white cardstock, stamp the butterfly and color with aquapainter.
8. Fussy cut butterfly and add to cardfront with a dimensional.
9. To create the envelope liner - simply use your Big Shot with the Envelope Liner framelits - use a

piece of 6"x 6" piece of DSP. It will slip right into the Whisper White envelope. Our magnetic platform is a great addition to the Big Shot- especialy when you are using framelits.
