PREPARING CARD

1. Cut an 8 1/2 x 11 sheet of Early Espresso cardstock in half, 8 1/2 x 5 1/2.
2. Cut a sheet of Roccoco Rose into a 4" x 5 1/4" base
3. Cut a piece of Designer Series Paper (DSP) into a 3 3/4" x 4" mat.
4. Die cut the larger die in picture using Early Espresso.
5. Die cut the smaller die in picture using Very Vanilla. Stamp sentiment in Roccoco Rose.
6. Stamp the flower image onto a scrap piece of Very Vanilla using Memento Ink.
7. Using the Roccoco Rose blends (both light and dark), color the entire flower using the light blend, then highlight darkened areas with darker blend. When complete, go back over with the light blend to help blend both colors. Use the dark Mango Melody blend to color the center of the flower.
8. Manually cut out flower image.
9. On the back of the flower image, add snail to the center.
10. Using linen thread, make three loops so that part of the thread sticks to the snail and the other three loops protrudes from the top half of the flower.
11. Cut a sheet of Very Vanilla cardstock into a 4" x 5 1/4" size (this is for the inside of the card. If you are going to stamp a sentiment on the inside of your card, do that now.
12. On the piece of DSP, stamp the leaf image two times using the Mossy Meadow stampin pad.

ASSEMBLING CARD

1. Attach the 4" x 5 1/4" cut piece of Very Vanilla to the inside of the card.
2. Attach the 4" x 5 1/4" cut piece of Roccoco Rose to the front of the card.
3. Attach the 3 3/4" x 5" piece of stamped DSP to the top of the Roccoco Rose mat.
4. Attach the stamped Very Vanilla piece to the Early Espresso die cut piece.
5. Add 2-3 large dimensionals to the back of the Early Espresso die cut piece and attach to the top center of the DSP.
6. Add 2 large dimensionals to the back of the cut flower piece and attach to the center of where both leafy images meet on the DSP.

PREPARING CARD

1. Cut an 8 1/2 x 11 sheet of Very Vanilla cardstock in half, 5 1/2" x 11". Stamp the back and set aside.
2. Cut a sheet of Grey Granite into a 4" x 5 1/4" base
3. Cut a piece of Very Vanilla cardstock into a 3" x 4" mat
4. Cut a piece of DSP into a 2 3/4" x 3 3/4" mat.
5. Die cut the largest leaf die from the Flourishing Dies out of Very Vanilla cardstock.
6. Die cut the 2nd to largest leaf die from the Flourishing Dies out of Basic Gray cardstock.
7. Cut a 1" x 4" piece of Gray Granite and punch each side using the Lovely Labels Pick a Punch (with your choice of end design).
8. Cut a 3" x 3/4" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock and stamp your sentiment.

ASSEMBLING CARD

1. Attach the 4" x 5 1/4" Gray Granite piece to the front of the card base.
2. Attach the DSP to the 3" x 4" Very Vanilla mat.
3. Attach a large dimensional to each corner on the back of the Very Vanilla mat.
4. Attach the mat to the center of the card base.
5. Using glue dots, attach the leaf die cuts to the middle left of the mat, at a slant.
6. Attach 2 large dimensionals to the back of the matted sentiment.
7. Attach the matted sentiment to the lower right part of the Very Vanilla mat.
8. Using double linen thread, make a bow and attach, with a glue dot to the base of where the dies meet the top of the sentiment mat.

PREPARING CARD

1. Cut an 8 1/2 x 11 sheet of Whisper White cardstock in half, 4 1/4" x 11". Score in half, lengthwise.
2. Cut a sheet of Rococco Rose cardstock into a 4" x 5 1/4" piece.
3. Cut a piece of DSP into a 3 3/4" x 5" piece.
4. Using a scrap piece of Whisper White cardstock, die cut the large die cut (see picture). Once cut, cut the die cut in half, length-wise.
5. Using a piece of DSP paper, die cut using the same die.
6. Emboss the sentiment. To emboss, wipe the DSP down with a dryer sheet to remove the static. Stamp the sentiment in Versamark. While the Versamark is still wet, sprinkle White Embossing Powder over the stamped sentiment. Shake piece to make sure that all areas of stamped sentiment get good powder coverage. Tap excess powder off image. The entire sentiment should be well defined with embossing powder and no extra loose powder left. Using the heating tool, heat up the embossing powder until it turns shiny. You might want to hold piece of DSP with a clothspin or use on a protected heat surface.
7. Using a scrap piece of Early Espresso cardstock, die cut 2 of the 2nd to largest size of Flourishing leaf dies.
8. Repeat the same die cuts using the scrap piece of cardstock Vellum.

ASSEMBLING CARD

1. Attach 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Rococco Rose to the front of the card.
2. Attach the 3 3/4" x 5" piece of DSP to the top of the Rococco Rose mat.
3. Using glue dots, attach the Early Espresso die cuts to the left of the card to where the leafs cover the left side of the card (see pic).
4. Using glue dots, attach the Vellum die cuts to the top of the Early Espresso die cuts.
5. Mat the embossed sentiment piece to the two Whisper White die cuts.
6. Attach 2-3 large dimensionals to the back of the matted piece and attach to the front center of card (to where the left of the mat covers the ends of where all the leafy die cuts come together).
7. Using the Linen Thread, tie a double bow and attach to the base of the leafy dies using 1-2 glue dots.
8. Attach an Epoxy Droplet to the center of the bow and attach a smaller droplet to the right of the sentiment.

PREPARING THE CARD

1. Cut an 8 1/2 x 11 sheet of Night of Navy cardstock in half, 8 1/2" x 5 1/2". Score in half, lengthwise, at 4 1/4". Stamp the back of the card and set aside.
2. Cut 2 sheets of Whisper White cardstock into 4" x 5 1/4" pieces.
3. Emboss one of the Whisper White cardstock pieces using the Textile Tile embossing folder.
4. Cut a piece of Night of Navy cardstock into a 3 1/4" x 4 1/2" piece.
5. Cut DSP into a 3" x 4 1/4" piece.
6. Using a scrap piece of Whisper White, die cut the image in the picture.
7. Stamp the sentiment onto the die cut piece.

ASSEMBLING CARD

1. Attach the embossed piece of Whisper White cardstock to the front of the card.
2. Attach the 2nd Whisper White piece to the inside of the card.
3. Attach the DSP piece to the 3 1/4" x 4 1/4" Night of Navy mat.
4. Attach adhesive to the center back left and right of Night of Navy mat.
5. Stretch a double 5" piece of Linen thread around the center of the card horizontally ensure the thread catches on to the adhesive on the back to hold in place.
6. Attach a large dimensional to the back corner of the Night of Navy mat.
7. Attach to the center of the card.
8. Using 1-2 large dimensionals, attach the sentiment die cut piece to the center right part of the card.
9. Using Linen Thread, make a double bow and attach to the Linen Thread on the mat. Attach it side-ways.
10. Attach an Epoxy Droplet to the center of the bow.

PREPARING THE CARD

1. Cut an 8 1/2 x 11 sheet of Very Vanilla cardstock in half, 4 1/4" x 11". Score in half, lengthwise, at 5 1/2". Stamp the back of the card and set aside.
2. Cut a sheet of Early Espresso cardstock into a 4" x 5 1/4" piece.
3. Cut a sheet of the wood grain DSP into a 3 3/4" x 5" piece.
4. Emboss the DSP with the Woodgrain embossing folder.
5. Die cut the large leafy die cut in cardstock Vellum.
6. Die cut 2 of the leafy dies in picture in Very Vanilla.
7. Die cut the large leafy die cut in Early Espresso.
8. Die cut the label in picture in Early Espresso. Cut in half, horizontally.
9. Die cut the label in picture in Very Vanilla. Stamp your sentiment.

ASSEMBLING CARD

1. Attach the Early Espresso piece to the front of the card.
2. Attach the embossed DSP piece to the top of the Early Espresso mat.
3. Using glue dots, attach the vellum die cuts first.
4. Using glue dots, attach the Very Vanilla die cuts on top of the Vellum die cuts.
5. Using a glue dot, attach the Early Espresso die cut to the center of the die cuts.
6. Mat the sentiment piece to both of the Early Espresso die cuts.
7. Attach 2 large dimensionals on the back of the matted stamp sentiment.
8. Attach to the base of where all the leafy die cuts meet.
9. Using the Linen Thread, make a double bow and attach to the base of where the leafy die cuts meet and top of mat piece.
10. Attach an Epoxy droplet to the center of the bow.
