Cut 5 1/2 x 8 1/2 Basic White, score at 4 1/4

Using 8 1/2 x 11 Basic White, with 8 1/2 along top of Paper Trimmer, score at 3/4, cut at 1 1/8, mark 1 1/2" from the end on the wider section, mark 3/4" from each end on the center score line, score between the marks going all the way to the edge of the paper, score from the corner over the center mark to the edge of the paper, turn and do the same thing on the other end, cut at 5" from each end, this gives you your two side mechanism, adhere to the inside of the card on the small edge fold the wide edge over until it lines up with the edge of the card. This is too hard to explain. Watch the video

Cut 3 3/4 x 4 Granny Apple Green Fruit Salad Designer Series Paper, adhere inside the card between the mechanisms

Cut (4) 2 x 3 1/2 Basic White, adhere to the mechanisms, one on each side

Cut 1 3/4 x 3 1/4 Daffodil Delight Fruit Salad Designer Series Paper, die cut circles in the center using the tree opening from the dies, stamp the critters, color bear with Pecan Pie & #600 on nose; color the racoon in Gray Granite light; adhere to back of the DSP through the opening

Stamp leaves in Tuxedo Black Momento on the Granny Apple Green scrap, die cut adhere to the doors

Die cut Hello in Basic White using the add on dies from July 2025 Paper Pumpkin Kit. adhere inside on Granny Apple Green

Cut 5 1/4 x 4 Granny Apple Green DSP from Fruit Salad, adhere to front of card

Cut 3 1/4 x 4 1/2 Basic White, adhere to center front of card

Cut 3 1/8 x 4 3/8 Daffodil Delight DSP to front of card

Stamp images in Tuxedo Black Momento, color bear with Pecan Pie & #600 on nose; color the racoon in Gray Granite light; color the porcupine with Crumb Cake

Die cut greeting tag using Stylish Shapes Dies, stamp greeting from Terrific Toadstools with VersaMark, add White Embossing Powder and heat with Heat Tool, images to the back, adhere to the front of the card using Dimensionals
