Dimensions:

- Early Espresso: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" (card base) and 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" (scallop circle)
- So Saffron: 5-1/4" x 4" (base layer)
- Cupcakes & Carousels Designer Series Paper (DSP): 3" x 4" (Bermuda Bay/So Saffron circles paper) and 2" x 3-1/2" (multi-colored diamond paper)
- Very Vanilla: 3" x 3" (circle)
- Bermuda Bay 1/8" Stitched Ribbon: 7" (base ribbon) & 9" (bow)

Instructions:

1. Fold the Early Espresso card base in half.
2. Attach the *Bermuda Bay/So Saffron circles paper* from the Cupcakes & Carousels DSP Stack to the center of the So Saffron base layer. Attach the *multi-colored diamond paper* to the left side of the paper, centering in-between the top and bottom edges of the base layer. See picture for placement.
3. Wrap the Bermuda Bay 1/8" Stitched Ribbon base piece around the bottom part of the base layer piece, and attach the ribbon ends to the back. Attach the So Saffron layer to the front of the Early Espresso card base.
4. Die-cut a circle out of the Very Vanilla piece using the *2nd largest circle die* from the Layering Circles Framelits Dies. Stamp the *string stamp* from the Any Occasion Stamp Set across the circle, a little above center, using the Early Espresso Classic Stampin' pad. Stamp the *"thank you" banner stamp* onto the center of the string using the Calypso Coral Classic Stampin' Pad. Stamp the *streamer stamp* onto each side of the "thank you" banner using the Bermuda Bay Classic Stampin' Pad.
5. Stamp the *string stamp* across the circle, at an angle, above the first banner (see picture for placement), using the Early Espresso ink pad. Stamp the *lace trio stamp* across the complete length of the string using the So Saffron Classic Stampin' Pad.
6. Stamp the *string stamp* again, across the bottom part of the circle with the Early Espresso ink pad. Stamp the right end of the *string stamp* again, above the bottom string, at an angle, and below the "thank you" banner. The right end of the string should be against the bottom, stamped string. See picture for placement.

- Stamp the *little banner stamp* across the short string using the Peekaboo Peach Classic Stampin' Pad. Stamp the *"thank you" stamp* onto the center of the bottom string using the Bermuda Bay ink pad. Stamp the *small heart stamp* onto each end of the thank you, and in-between thank and you, using the Calypso Coral ink pad.
- Die-cut a scallop circle from the Early Espresso scallop circle piece using the *second largest scallop circle die*. Attach the stamped circle to the center of the scallop circle, and then attach it all to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Tie the last ribbon piece into a bow, and attach it to the left side of the scallop circle, using a Mini Glue Dot.
