

# Magazine Holders RELOADED

Aren't these just the cutest? I LOVE bows so I had to top off the holders with a cute little bow. My note books are ready to be filled with new ideas.

Easy to do...here's the directions:

1. Get inexpensive magazine holders, mine are from Ikea but you could reuse ones you have as well.
2. Pick out two pieces of 12 x 12 DSP
3. Keep the holder flat. Use Fast Fuse around the perimeter of one side and a little in the middle.
4. Place your full piece of 12 x 12 DSP carefully on the holder with the excess DSP toward the back (this will cover the bull back) and the straight edge on the front side edge. Press down to adhere.
5. Flip it over so you can see where to trim the excess away. Use a sharp cutter to trim the curve but don't discard the scrap.
6. Leave the excess in the back, we will adhere this at the end.
7. Now do the other side the same as #4
8. Use Fast Fuse to adhere excess pieces in the back. This makes the perfect back and it's completely covered.
9. For the front, measure height and width, cut your coordinating piece of DSP, use Fast Fuse around the perimeter and carefully place on the piece of DSP.
10. I used the Bow Builder Punch to create the cute bow on the fronts of both. There's a video on my BLOG for this great punch. It's adhered with Glue Dots.
