During Contract performance, Contractor shall identify and make available to Purchasers upon request a list of subcontractors, dealers, and distributors who will supply products or perform services in fulfillment of Contract requirements. Information shall include their name, the nature of services to be performed or products to be sold by product category/subcategory, address, telephone, facsimile, email, and federal tax identification number (TIN) (if the company is authorized to sell and invoice for products and services).

7. Price Agreement Number:

All purchase orders issued by purchasing entities within the jurisdiction of this participating addendum shall include the Participating State contract number: **[insert appropriate number]** and the Lead State master price agreement number: 06913.

8. Individual Customer:

Each State agency and political subdivision, as a Participating Entity, that purchases products/services will be treated as if they were Individual Customers. The Contractor will apply the charges to each Participating Entity individually.

This Participating Addendum and the Master Agreement number 06913 (administered by the State of Washington) together with its exhibits, set forth the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter of all previous communications, representations or agreements, whether oral or written, with respect to the subject matter hereof. Terms and conditions inconsistent with, contrary or in addition to the terms and conditions of this Addendum and the Master Agreement, together with its exhibits, shall not be added to or incorporated into this Addendum or the Master Agreement and its exhibits, by any subsequent purchase order or otherwise, and any such attempts to add or incorporate such terms and conditions are hereby rejected. The terms and conditions of this Addendum and the Master Agreement and its exhibits shall prevail and govern in the case of any such inconsistent or additional terms within the Participating State.

My staff has been in contact with you regarding your need to act quickly to acquire in-vehicle repeaters under your FEMA grant. Your inquiry has been directed to me. Thank you for your interest in NASPO ValuePoint formerly WSCA-NASPO. We are happy to hear that the West Webster Fire District is interested in executing a NASPO ValuePoint agreement with Pyramid Communications. Please let us offer you some background information. NASPO (National Association of State Procurement Officials) is a non-profit professional, educational association of state Chief Procurement Officers (CPOs) dedicated to elevating the performance of state public procurement through education, research, collaboration, and cooperation among the states. Chief Procurement Officials in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and U.S. territories are members of NASPO.

Since CPOs are members they have the ability to use or allow use of NASPO ValuePoint cooperative contracts. NASPO ValuePoint has a Management Board consisting of a volunteer group of 21 state CPOs representing all regions of the country. Solicitations are processed and awarded by a lead state under direction of its Chief Procurement Officer in accordance with its state procurement statutes.
