# For: The State of Alabama Under the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement

# <u>Utilization Reports - Monthly</u>

A utilization report shall be submitted to the Alabama Department of Finance, Division of Accounting and Administration for all state and local government entities purchases providing the following information:

The reports shall be in an Excel format. The reports will provide statistical data on all purchases made from the awarded contract by state and local procurement entities for the reported month. The reports shall be sent electronically (no hard copies required or permitted) to: telecom.admin@isd.alabama.gov. Failure to submit reports and fees on a timely basis shall constitute grounds for suspension of this agreement.

The report shall be detailed; broken down by line item and include the following data:

- 1. Contract Number
- 2. Reporting Month and Year
- 3. Agency or local government entity
- 4. Commodity description
- 5. Line item quantity purchased for the reported month for each individual agency or local government entity.
- 6. Line item dollar amount (volume) purchased for the reported month for each individual agency or local government entity.
- 7. Subtotals for each category above.
- 8. Grand totals for each category above.
- 9. The Administrative Fee Dollar amount paid to the State each reported month.

# ADMINISTRATIVE FEE - Monthly

The contractor shall submit a check, in addition to the utilization report, payable to the State of Alabama for the calculated administrative fee for an amount equal to one percent (1%) of total dollar amount for all sales made as stated above for a monthly period. A report is due even when there is no activity. The administrative fee and utilization report will be made on or before the 20<sup>th</sup> day of each month for the prior month's transactions made. The administrative fee will represent a one time payment for all sales made in the prior month and as adjusted for error corrections associated with earlier month.

## SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All State agencies must use this contract, as established through the Division of Purchasing. State agencies that have their own procurement authority have the option to utilize this contract. This contract may also be available to local governments.

Section 41-16-27, Code of Alabama 1975 states that contracts for the purchase of personal property or contractual services other than personal services shall be let by competitive bid for periods not greater than five years. This agreement shall not exceed the original terms of the contract/agreement nor shall it exceed five (5) years whichever comes first.

Contract vendor must be actively subscribed and remain active with State Purchasing for the life of the contract. Subscriptions may be completed by following the "Pay Subscription Fee" link at <a href="https://procurement.staars.alabama.gov">https://procurement.staars.alabama.gov</a> or follow the Vendor Self Service link at <a href="https://www.purchasing.alabama.gov">www.purchasing.alabama.gov</a>.

Contract vendor must comply with the requirements of the Beason-Hammon Alabama Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act (Act 2011-535) and as amended by Act 2012-491. See page 3 of Attachment A.

Section 41-16-82, Code of Alabama 1975 requires the disclosure statement to be completed and filed with all proposals, bids, contracts, or grant proposals to the State of Alabama in excess of \$5,000. In circumstances where a contract is awarded by competitive bid, the disclosure statement shall be required only from the person receiving the contract and shall be submitted within ten (10) days of the award.

Penalty for agencies paying invoices late may not exceed the rate charged by State of Alabama Comptroller's Office.

Page 2, item 5 of the Participating Addendum: The State of Alabama contract users will only purchase items from distributors physically located within the State of Alabama. Contract Vendor must submit a list of authorized Alabama distributors prior to the execution of this agreement. Alabama distributors must create an account on the Vendor Self Service site (see web link above). However, distributors are not required to be actively subscribed.

#### Dear Vendor:
