



Request for Proposal (“RFP”) DASPS-2114-16  
ADDENDUM No. 1

This Addendum No. 1 (“Addendum”) modifies the RFP which DAS PS published on ORPIN on May 9, 2016. This Addendum modifies the RFP as described herein. All RFP terms not specifically mentioned or affected by this Addendum remain in full force. This Addendum is hereby added as a part of the RFP.

The RFP is modified as described below. New language is indicated by bold print and underline. Deleted language is indicated by strikethrough.

1. RFP, Section 2.3.3 Permissive Cooperative Procurement.

In addition to Oregon, the following Participating States have requested to be named in this RFP as potential users of the resulting Master Agreement: North Dakota, Maine, Virginia, South Dakota, Nevada, Montana, Washington, Arkansas, Vermont, Hawaii, Illinois, and Utah. However this is not a guarantee that any State will issue a Participating Addendum. Other entities may become Participating Entities after award of the Master Agreement. State-specific terms and conditions that will govern each state’s Participating Addendum are included in Attachment I (State of Oregon); Attachment ~~J, K, L, M, N, and O~~ **J, K, L, M, N, O, P, and Q**, or may be incorporated into the Participating Addendum after award. Other entities may become Participating Entities after award of the Master Agreement. Some States may have included special or unique terms and conditions for their state that will govern their state Participating Addendum. These terms and conditions are being provided as a courtesy to Proposers to indicate which additional terms and conditions may be incorporated into the state Participating Addendum after award of the Master Agreement. The Lead State will not address questions or concerns or negotiate other States’ terms and conditions. The Participating States shall negotiate these terms and conditions directly with the supplier.

2. RFP, DASPS-2114-16\_Addendum No. 1, Attachment P and Q Illinois and Hawaii State specific terms and conditions are added as part of the RFP, as attached hereto.

3. Proposers questions and DAS PS responses:

Question 1: We are a NJ based company that interested in RFP for Parks and Recreation Equipment and Related Services in the State of Oregon. On Exhibit No. 3 it is asking for Oregon Tax #. Do we need to have a contractor’s license in Oregon?

Answer 1: Yes, unless you are otherwise exempt, if you are going to submit a proposal for a nationwide Master Agreement. The State of Oregon will be awarding and administering the nationwide Master Agreements. If the you are considering offering to provide products and services in only one state (and not in Oregon), then, potentially you may not be required to obtain an Oregon Tax number, as you will not be providing any products or services in Oregon.
