The contractor shall provide solutions and perform the services specified by the State of Missouri's various state and local government agencies at the firm, fixed discounts specified contract established between the State of Washington and Power Products Unlimited, Inc. For purposes of the provision of products and services to the State of Missouri and its state and local government agencies, all references to the State of Washington's Division of Purchasing and NASPO ValuePoint, in the attached documentation shall be deemed to refer to the State of Missouri with the exception of information specific to State of Washington's Division of Purchasing and NASPO ValuePoint such as background information, statistical/factual information, etc.

The contractor shall submit invoices for Public Safety Communications Equipment – Radios, Batteries, Portable Radio, provided for the State of Missouri to the address shown on the ordering agency's purchasing order.

## Missouri Statewide Contract Quarterly Administrative Fee:

The contractor shall pay a one percent (1%) administrative fee to the State of Missouri which shall apply to all payments received by the contractor for all products and services provided under the contract by state agencies, political subdivisions and other entities in the State of Missouri. Payment of the one percent administrative fee shall be non-negotiable.

The contractor shall pay the administrative fee at the end of each calendar quarter (i.e. March 31, June 30, September 30, December 31). The total administrative fee for a given quarter must equal one percent (1%) of the total payments (minus returns and credits) received by the contractor during the calendar quarter as reported on the contractor's Missouri Statewide Contract Quarterly Administrative Fee Report specified below. The administrative fee must be received by the Division of Purchasing (Purchasing) no later than the 15th calendar day of the month immediately following the end of the calendar quarter, unless the 15th is not a business day in which case the next business day thereafter shall be considered the administrative fee deadline.

## Batteries, Portable Radio

- 2. Participation: Use of specific NASPO ValuePoint cooperative contracts by state agencies governed by RSMO Chapter 34, political subdivisions, and other entities (including cooperatives) and universities authorized by Missouri's statutes to use state contracts are approved by the Director of the Division of Purchasing for the State of Missouri. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the Director of the Division of Purchasing.
