- 1. <u>Scope</u>: This addendum covers the WIRELESS SERVICES lead by the State of Nevada for use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating **State/Entity** authorized by that state's statutes to utilize **state/entity** contracts.
- 2. <u>Participation:</u> All eligible purchasers within the State of Arkansas including State Agencies, K-12, and local public procurement units (cities, counties, municipalities) are authorized to purchase products and services under the terms and conditions of this price agreement.

INDIVIDUAL CUSTOMER: Each State agency and political subdivision, as a Participating Entity, that purchases products/services will be treated as if they were Individual Customers. Except to the extent modified by this Participating Addendum, each agency and political subdivision will be responsible to follow the terms and conditions of the Master Agreement; and they will have the same rights and responsibilities for their purchases as the Lead State has in the Master Agreement. Each agency and political subdivision will be responsible for their own charges, fees, and liabilities. Each agency and political subdivision will have the same rights to any indemnity or to recover any costs allowed in the contract for their purchases. The Contractor will apply the charges to each Participating Entity individually.

- 3. Participating State Modifications or Additions to Master Price Agreement:
 - 1. The laws of the State of Arkansas shall govern this agreement.
 - 2. Payments shall be submitted to the Contractor at the address shown on the invoice. Payment shall be tendered to the contractor within thirty (30) days of the date of invoice. After the sixtieth (60) day from the date of the invoice unless mutually agreed to, interest shall be paid on the unpaid balance due to the contractor at the rate of one half of one percent per month in accordance with Arkansas Code Annotated §19-11-224. The procuring agency shall make a good-faith effort to pay within thirty (30) days after the date of invoice.
 - 3. Records relevant to Purchasing Entity transactions shall be subject to examination by appropriate government authorities for a period of five (5) years from the date of acceptance of the purchase order, provided, however, that such government authorities shall provide thirty (30) days written notice to Contractor of its intent to conduct such examination contemplated by this Section 3. The purchasing entity shall have the right to audit billing either before or after payment during normal business hours. Payment under this agreement shall not foreclose the right of the purchasing entity to recover excessive or illegal payments. Further, due to the highly sensitive and proprietary nature of Contractor's records, any third party auditor acting on behalf of the purchasing entity shall be subject to prior approval by Contractor and may be required at Contractor's sole discretion to execute Contractor's standard Non-Disclosure Agreement prior to examining, inspecting, copying or auditing Contractor's records.
 - 4. A Purchasing Entity shall determine whether all Products and services delivered meet the Contractor's published specifications. No payment shall be made for any Products or Services until the Purchasing Entity has accepted the Products or Services. The Purchasing Entity will make every effort to notify the Contractor

within thirty (30) calendar days of non-acceptance of a product or service; otherwise the Products or Services shall be deemed accepted.

- 5. The contractor and the state have the right to pursue any other remedy permitted by law or in equity.
- 6. Under Arkansas law, state agencies (the "State") may not enter into a covenant or agreement to hold a party harmless or to indemnify a party from prospective damages. However, without waiving any or all sovereign immunities, with respect to loss, expense, damage, liability, claims or demands, either at law or in equity, for actual or alleged injuries to persons or property arising out of any negligent act or omission by the State or its employees or agents in the performance of this agreement, the State agrees with Tessco that: (a) it will reasonably cooperate with Tessco in the defense of any action or claim brought against Tessco seeking the foregoing damages or relief; (b) it will in good faith address with Tessco should Tessco present any claims of the foregoing nature against the State to the Claims Commission of the State of Arkansas; however, the State reserves its right to assert in good faith all claims and defenses available to it in any proceedings in said Claims Commission or other appropriate forum. The obligations of this paragraph shall survive the expiration or termination of this agreement.
- 7. In the event the State no longer needs the service or commodity due to program changes, changes in laws, rules, or regulations, relocation of offices, or lack of appropriated funding, the State may cancel the Participating Addendum by giving the contractor(s) written notice of such cancellation 30 days prior to the date of cancellation.
- 8. Vendor shall be required to provide annual customer activity reports to the Office of State Procurement. The reports shall be provided by September 1 each year. The Contract Activity Report format <u>must</u> be in Microsoft Excel format and include: Customer Type, Agency Name, Agency Purchase Order Number, Purchase Order Date, Ship Date, Invoice Number, Product Number, Product Description, List/MSRP Price, Customer Price, Quantity, Total Price. Reports outlined in this section <u>must</u> be sent to: OSP.ITContracts@dfa.arkansas.gov. Nothing in this paragraph shall be construed to require the Contractor to report on any products or services purchased by employees of the eligible entities herein for which there is no governmental liability.
- 4. Lease Agreements: Leasing is NOT authorized under the category awarded for this contract.
