1. **Scope:** This addendum covers the Data Communications Products and Services 14-19 contracts led by the State of Utah for use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating State authorized by that state's statutes to utilize state contracts with the prior approval of the state's chief procurement official.

2. **Participation:** Use of specific WSCA-NASPO cooperative contracts by agencies, political subdivisions and other entities (including cooperatives) authorized by an individual state's statutes to use state contracts are subject to the prior approval of the respective State Chief Procurement Official. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

3. **Participating State Modifications or Additions to Master Agreement:**

**Workers' Compensation Insurance:** The Contractor shall provide and maintain, for all employees engaged in work under this contract, coverage as required by AS 23.30.045, and; where applicable, any other statutory obligations including but not limited to Federal U.S.L. & H. and Jones Act requirements. The policy must waive subrogation against the State.

Certificates of Insurance must be furnished to the DGS Contracting Officer within 30 calendar days of execution of this PA and must provide for a notice of cancellation, non-renewal, of material change of conditions in accordance with policy provisions.

**Required Reports:** Contractor must submit quarterly reports to the Contracting Officer assigned by the State to manager this contract. This report must show all purchases made under this contract in the state of Alaska and list it by the total purchases made by each entity. The State will work with the Contractor to develop this report. These reports are due 30 days after the end of the quarter.

First Quarter	July 1 through September 30
Second Quarter	October 1 through December 31
Third Quarter	January 1 through March 31
Fourth Quarter	April 1 through June 30

4. **Lease Agreements:** Entities entitled to purchase under this Participating Addendum that have authority to enter into lease agreements may do so to obtain hardware, software and services under the Master Agreement.

7. **Orders:** Any Order placed by a Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity for a Product and/or Service available from this Master Agreement shall be deemed to be a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions) of the Master Agreement unless the parties to the Order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to such Order.



