TO CONTRACT NO. 04615 NASPO INK AND TONER

This Fourth Amendment ("Amendment") to Contract No. 04615 is made and entered into by and between the State of Washington acting by and through the Department of Enterprise Services, a Washington State governmental agency ("State") and Office Depot, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Contractor") and is dated as of March 1, 2018.

RECITALS

- A. State and Contractor (collectively the "Parties") entered into that certain Contract No. 04615 for Ink and Toner dated effective as of September 1, 2015 ("Contract").
- B. The Parties previously amended the Contract three (3) times.
 - 1. Amendment 1: Dated January 29, 2016 to extend contract term.
 - 2. Amendment 2: Dated March 1, 2017 to extend contract term.
 - 3. Amendment 3: Dated April 1, 2017 to increase Vendor Management Fee to 1.5%
- C. The amendment set forth herein is within the scope of the Contract.
- D. The Parties now desire to amend the Contract as set forth herein.

AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein, the Parties hereby agree to amend the Contract, as previously amended, as follows:

- 1. TERM. This amendment is to extend the term of the contract twelve months from 03/01/2018 to 02/28/2019.
- 2. NO CHANGE OTHER THAN AMENDMENT. Except as amended herein, the Contract is unaffected and remains in full force and effect.

- 3. INTEGRATED AGREEMENT; MODIFICATION. This Amendment constitutes the entire agreement and understanding of the Parties with respect to the subject matter and supersedes all prior negotiations and representations. In the event of any conflict between this Amendment and the Contract or any earlier amendment, this Amendment shall control and govern. This Amendment may not be modified except in writing signed by the Parties.
- 4. AUTHORITY. Each party to this Amendment, and each individual signing on behalf of each party, hereby represents and warrants to the other that it has full power and authority to enter into this Amendment and that its execution, delivery, and performance of this Amendment has been fully authorized and approved, and that no further approvals or consents are required to bind such party.
- 5. ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES. A signed copy of this Amendment or any other ancillary agreement transmitted by facsimile, email, or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original executed copy of this Amendment or such other ancillary agreement for all purposes.
- 6. COUNTERPARTS. This Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which counterparts together shall constitute the same instrument which may be sufficiently evidenced by one counterpart. Execution of this Amendment at different times and places by the parties shall not affect the validity thereof so long as all the parties hereto execute a counterpart of this Amendment.

This Participating Addendum for the above referenced Master Agreement ("Participating Addendum") is made and entered into by and between the State of Washington acting by and through the Department of Enterprise Services, a Washington State governmental agency ("Enterprise Services") and Office Depot, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Contractor") and is dated and effective as of September 1, 2017.

- SCOPE: This Participating Addendum covers Digital Print and Quick Copy Services led by the State of
 Utah for use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating State authorized by that
 state's statutes to utilize state contracts with the prior approval of the State's chief procurement
 official.
- 2. PARTICIPATION: Use of specific NASPO ValuePoint cooperative contracts by agencies, political subdivisions and other entities (including cooperatives) authorized by an individual state's statutes to use state contracts are subject to the prior approval of the respective State chief procurement official. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State chief procurement official. Pursuant to this Participating Addendum, the Master Agreement may be utilized by the following ("Purchasing Entities"):
 - (a) WASHINGTON STATE AGENCIES. Washington state agencies, departments, offices, divisions, boards, and commission; and any the following institutions of higher education in Washington: state universities, regional universities, state college, community colleges, and technical colleges.
 - Pertaining to RCW 43.19.739, Washington State agencies in Thurston County shall consult with Department of Enterprise Services, Printing and Imaging prior to utilizing this contract for their printing needs.

- (b) MCUA PARTIES. The Master Agreement also may be utilized by any of the following types of entities that have executed a Master Contract Usage Agreement (MCUA) with Enterprise Services:
 - Political subdivisions (e.g., counties, cities, school districts, public utility districts);
 - Federal governmental agencies or entities;
 - Public-benefit nonprofit corporations (i.e., § 501(c) (3) nonprofit corporations that receive federal, state, or local funding); and
 - Federally-recognized Indian Tribes located in the State of Washington.

3. PARTICIPATING STATE MODIFICATIONS OR ADDITIONS TO MASTER AGREEMENT:

- 3.1. Washington's Electronic Business Solutions (WEBS) System: Within seven (7) days of execution of this Participating Addendum, Contractor shall register in the Washington State Department of Enterprise Services' Electronic Business Solutions (WEBS) System at https://fortress.wa.gov/ga/webcust/home.html. Contractor shall ensure that all of its information therein is current and accurate and that, throughout the term of the Master Agreement, Contractor shall maintain an accurate profile in WEBS.
- 3.2. Washington's Statewide Payee Desk: To be paid for contract sales, Contractors must register with Washington's Statewide Payee Desk. Washington state agencies cannot make payments to a contractor until it is registered. Registration materials are available here: Receiving Payment from the State.
- 3.3. **CONTRACT SALES REPORTING.** Contractor shall report total contract sales quarterly to Enterprise Services, as set forth below.
 - (a) REPORTING. Contractor shall report quarterly Contract sales in Enterprise Services' Contract Sales Reporting System. Enterprise Services will provide Contractor with a login password and a vendor number.
 - (b) DATA. Each sales report must identify every authorized Purchasing Entity by name as it is known to Enterprise Services and its total combined sales amount invoiced during the reporting period (i.e., sales of an entire agency or political subdivision, not its individual subsections). The "Miscellaneous" option may be used only with prior approval by Enterprise Services. Upon request, Contractor shall provide contact information for all authorized Purchasing Entities specified herein during the term of this Participating Addendum. Refer sales reporting questions to the Primary Contact set forth below. If there are no contract sales during the reporting period, Contractor must report zero sales.
 - (c) DUE DATES FOR CONTRACT SALES REPORTING. Quarterly Contract Sales Reports must be submitted electronically by the following deadlines for all sales invoiced during the applicable calendar quarter:

- 3.4. VENDOR MANAGEMENT FEE: Contractor shall pay to Enterprise Services a vendor management fee ("VMF") of one and one-half percent ("1.5"%) on the purchase price for all contract "Spend". For the purpose of this Amendment, Spend shall be defined as the total invoice price less applicable sales tax, shipping fees (if applicable), or, product returns from the prior quarter.
 - (a) The sum owed by Contractor to Enterprise Services as a result of the VMF is calculated as follows:

Amount owed to Enterprise Services = Total Spend (as defined in 3.4) x .015.

The amount of the VMF shall be rolled into end user's current unit pricing. The VMF shall be included as an equivalent adjustment to NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement Pricing.

The VMF must not be shown as a separate line item on any invoice unless specifically requested and approved by Enterprise Services.

- (b) Enterprise Services will invoice Contractor quarterly based on contract sales reported by Contractor. Contractor shall not remit payment until it receives an invoice from Enterprise Services. Contractor's VMF payment to Enterprise Services must reference the following:
 - This Washington Master Contract No.: 02516
 - The NASPO Master Agreement No.: PD2454
 - The year and quarter for which the VMF is being remitted, and
 - Contractor's name as set forth in this Contract, if not already included on the face of the check.
- (c) Contractor's failure to accurately and timely report total Spend, to submit usage reports, or remit payment of the VMF to Enterprise Services, may be cause for suspension or termination of this Participating Addendum or the exercise of any other remedies as provided by law.
- (d) Enterprise Services reserves the right, upon thirty (30) days advance written notice to Contractor, to increase, reduce, or eliminate the VMF for subsequent purchases.
- 3.5. COMPLIANCE WITH LAW; TAXES, LICENSES, & REGISTRATION: Contractor shall comply with all applicable law. Contractor shall register to conduct business in the State of Washington and promptly acquire and maintain all necessary licenses and registrations and pay all applicable taxes and fees. In addition, for all sales to purchasers in the State of Washington, Contractor shall calculate, collect, and remit, as appropriate, the applicable state and local sales tax on all invoices.

- 4. <u>LEASE AGREEMENTS</u>: Leasing, renting, or purchasing equipment is not allowed throughout the term of this Master Agreement.
- 5. <u>PRIMARY CONTACTS</u>: The primary contact individuals for this Participating Addendum are as follows (or their named successors):

The Contractor's Distributor's participation will be in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the aforementioned Master Agreement.
- 7. ORDERS: Unless the parties to the Order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to such order, any Order placed by Participating State or a Purchasing Entity for a Product and/or Service available from this Master Agreement shall be deemed to be a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions of) the Master Agreement as conditioned by this Participating Addendum.

8. **GENERAL**:

- (a) INTEGRATED AGREEMENT; MODIFICATION. This Participating Addendum and Master Agreement, together with its exhibits, set forth the entire agreement and understanding of the Parties with respect to the subject matter and supersedes all prior negotiations and representations.
