The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approves the following six Master Agreements for a Provider Services Module:

- Client Network Services, LLC (CNSI)
- Digital Harbor, Inc.
- DXC Technology Services, LLC
- HHS Technology Group, LLC
- Maximus Human Services, Inc.
- OptumInsight, Inc.

CMS is approving all six Master Agreements which can be leveraged by any state. Any state Participating Addendums should be submitted to their CMS analyst for review and approval as part of the normal contract workflow. CMS will review any such submissions and provide approval or request additional information within 30 days of receipt of the request.

This approval is effective as of the date of this letter and expires on September 30, 2025. There is potential for three additional optional years per state and vendor agreement.

This approval is in accordance with 45 CFR 95.611 and SMM §11200 and requires that all revisions and amendments to the Master Agreements or Participating Addendums must receive CMS' prior written approval to qualify for Federal Financial Participation (FFP).

Please be advised that States must be in compliance with all Federal regulations when seeking Federal funding. In particular, 45 CFR 95.611 outlines all the provisions and conditions that all states must meet when requesting regular and enhanced FFP funding. As outlined on this regulation, "Failure to submit any of the above to the satisfaction of the Department may result in disapproval or suspension of project funding."
