Contract CC191557001 is awarded by the State of Missouri consisting of the following:

❖ The attached Contract #19102, signed by the State of Iowa on 12/14/18.

❖ The attached RFP #1118005083 issued by the State of Iowa on May 18, 2018 consisting of 73 pages.

The contractor shall provide the supplies and services specified by the State of Missouri at the firm, fixed prices specified in the attached documentation. All references to the <u>State of Iowa</u>, in the attached documentation shall be deemed to refer to the State of Missouri with the exception of information specific to the State of Iowa such as background information, statistical/factual information, etc.

The contractor shall submit invoices for supplies and services provided for the State of Missouri to the address shown on Page 1.

## Federal Funds Requirement:

The contractor shall understand and agree that this procurement may involve the expenditure of federal funds. Therefore, in accordance with the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, Public Law 101-166, Section 511, "Steven's Amendment", the contractor shall not issue any statements, press releases, and other documents describing projects or programs funded in whole or in part with Federal funds unless the prior approval of the state agency is obtained and unless they clearly state the following as provided by the state agency:

- the percentage of the total costs of the program or project which will be financed with Federal funds;
- the dollar amount of Federal funds for the project or program; and
- percentage and dollar amount of the total costs of the project or program that will be financed by nongovernmental sources.

## **Debarment Certification:**

The contractor certifies by signing the signature page of this original document and any addendum signature page(s) that the contractor is not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, voluntarily excluded from participation, or otherwise excluded from or ineligible for participation under federal assistance programs. ## **Cooperative Procurement Program:**

The contractor shall participate in the State of Missouri's Cooperative Procurement Program. The contractor shall provide tires, tubes and services as described herein under the terms and conditions, requirements and specifications of the contract, including prices, to other government entities in accordance with the Technical Services Act (section 67.360, RSMo, which is available on the internet at: http://www.moga.mo.gov/mostatutes/stathtml/06700003601.html). The contractor shall further understand and

agree that participation by other governmental entities is discretionary on the part of that governmental entity and the State of Missouri bears no financial responsibility for any payments due to the contractor by such governmental entities.

## Contractor's Personnel:

The contractor shall only employ personnel authorized to work in the United States in accordance with applicable federal and state laws. This includes but is not limited to the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act (IIRIRA) and INA Section 274A.

If the contractor is found to be in violation of this requirement or the applicable state, federal and local laws and regulations, and if the State of Missouri has reasonable cause to believe that the contractor has knowingly employed individuals who are not eligible to work in the United States, the state shall have the right to cancel the contract immediately without penalty or recourse and suspend or debar the contractor from doing business with the state.

The contractor shall agree to fully cooperate with any audit or investigation from federal, state, or local law enforcement agencies.

## Missouri Statewide Contract Quarterly Administrative Fee:

The contractor shall pay a one percent (1%) administrative fee to the State of Missouri which shall apply to all payments received by the contractor for all products provided under the contract. Payment of the one percent administrative fee shall be non-negotiable.
