Master Agreement Terms and Conditions:

- Scope: This addendum covers the Copiers & Managed Print Services led by the State of Colorado for use by the Kansas Department of Administration, Office of Printing, Mail Services and Surplus Property and other non-state level entities located in the Participating State of Kansas authorized by that State's statutes to utilize State contracts with the prior approval of the State's Chief Procurement Official.
- 2. Participation: This NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement may be used by the Kansas Department of Administration, Office of Printing, Mail Services and Surplus Property, institutions of higher institution, political subdivisions and other entities authorized to use statewide contracts in the State of Kansas. State of Kansas level agencies may not utilize this contract without approval from the State Chief Procurement Officer and the Director of the Office of Printing, Mail Services and Surplus Property. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

 - b. Reports and Administrative Fees: The Contractor shall submit calendar quarterly reports to the Division of Purchases for all acquisitions, less returned product ("actual, net invoice sales"), made from this Addendum. This report should include as a minimum the agency name, quantity, description and amount. The report will be provided electronically, and a check sent payable to the State of Kansas Office

of Procurement and Contracts for an amount equal to 0.25% of the total actual sales for purchases made by State of Kansas agencies or any Kansas political subdivisions. The report and fee shall be submitted 30 days following the end of the calendar quarter to reports@da.ks.gov.

- c. Political Subdivisions are responsible for processing purchase orders directly with the Contractor.
- d. A State of Kansas, Tax Clearance Certificate is required to execute this contract.
- e. Order of precedence is modified as follows:
 - i. State of Kansas Contractual Provisions Attachment (as modified), DA-146a attached and incorporated into this Addendum as Attachment A.
 - ii. This Participating Addendum
 - iii. The NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement #140602

5. Lease Agreements:

Lease Terms: Equipment leases are subject to the Terms and Conditions as set forth in the Master Agreement, unless otherwise agreed to. To initiate a lease, Purchasing Entity may issue a Purchase Order ("PO") and reference the type of lease (FMV, Straight, or Capital Lease) on the PO or may simply sign other transactional documents deemed acceptable to the parties.

All lease and rental programs must remain with the Contractor through an in-house leasing program.

End of Term Notification: Contractor must notify a Purchasing Entity, in writing, of their End of Term options at least sixty (60) to ninety (90) days prior to the end of any Initial Lease or Rental Term. Such notification may include, but not be limited to, the following:

- i. Any acquisition or return options, based on the type of lease or rental agreement;
- ii. Any renewal options, if applicable; and/or
- iii. Hard drive removal and surrender cost, if applicable.

End of Term Options: If a Purchasing Entity desires to exercise a purchase, renewal, or return of the Equipment, it shall give Contractor at least thirty (30) days written notice prior to the expiration of such lease or rental term. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, if Purchasing Entity fails to notify Contractor of its intent with respect to the exercise of a purchase, renewal, or return of the Equipment, the Initial Lease or Rental Term shall be terminated on the date as stated in the Order and removal of the Product will be mutually arranged.

- 6. Orders: Any order placed by a Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity for a product and/or service available from this Master Agreement shall be deemed to be a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions) of the Master Agreement unless the parties to the order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to such order.
 - All orders should contain the following (1) "PO subject to NASPO ValuePoint Contract #140602 & State Contract 47160" (2) Purchaser's, Address, Contact, & Phone-Number (3) Purchase order amount (4) Type of Lease (FMV, Straight, or Capital lease) and monthly payment (5) Itemized list of accessories (6) Service program and rates (7) Attached SOW Template if applicable.
- 7. Product Installation & Invoicing: Unless otherwise agreed to by both parties, signing the delivery and acceptance ("D&A") certificate constitutes Acceptance of the Product(s) and allows Contractor to invoice for the Product(s). Failure to sign the D&A or reject the Product(s) within the foregoing five (5) day period shall be deemed as Acceptance by the Purchasing Entity.

Contractor will provide timely billing and Customer will notify Contractor, in writing, of any billing concern. In order for Contractor to generate accurate service invoices, Purchasing Entities shall provide meter reads within the Contractor(s) requested timeframe.

Invoices that are generated without receiving the proper meter read information from the Purchasing Entity will not be considered inaccurate.

The Purchasing Entity shall provide written notice of any alleged invoicing issue(s) and the Contractor will be allowed a thirty (30) day cure period to address any such issue. Failure on the Contractor(s) part to maintain accurate invoicing shall result in a \$25.00 per instance credit on the following month's invoice.

- 8. <u>Not Specifically Priced ("NSP") Open Market Items</u>: Not Specifically Priced (NSP) items compliment or enhance the Products and/or Services offered under the resulting Master Agreement(s). NSP items will not include:
 - i) Interactive White boards;
 - ii) Computers, monitors, or other related items;
 - iii) Fax machines;
 - iv) Overhead Projectors; and
 - v) Cameras.

NSP items may only be acquired through the Contractor(s) or their Authorized Dealer(s) and must be reported quarterly with all other sales under the resulting Master Agreement(s).

NSP items must be priced at a minimum discount of 15% from MSRP or List Price. NSP items shall <u>not</u> be offered to a Purchasing Entity as a stand-alone option, and the maximum allowable amount of all NSP items in a single Order shall be determined by the Participating State or Entity.

- 9. <u>Showroom Equipment</u>: Upon request by a Purchasing Entity, showroom Equipment for Groups C may be converted to a purchase, lease, or rental providing the following conditions are met:
 - a. The meter count on Group C Devices does not exceed 50,000 copies total (i.e. b&w and color combined);
 - b. The Device must be discounted by at least 5% off the Master Agreement pricing for that same Device; and the Purchasing Entity and the Contractor must indicate on the Order that the Device is a showroom model.
- 10. <u>Software</u>: Purchasing Entities that acquire software shall be subject to the license agreements distributed with such software. Software subscriptions shall not be subject to automatic renewals. Purchasing Entities shall have the option to finance software subscriptions by utilizing Contractor lease and rental rates. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the event of a conflict in language between an end user license agreement (EULA) and the Master Agreement, the language in the Master Agreement will supersede and control. In addition, any language in a EULA which violates a participating state's constitution or a statute of that state; or violates the laws of a local entity making a purchase, will be deemed void, and of no force or effect, as applied to the participating or purchasing entity.
- 11. <u>Maintenance Service Level Agreements</u>: Purchasing Entities are subject to the Contractor "Maintenance Service Level Agreement" provided in Participating Addendum **Exhibit A**.
- 12. <u>Managed Print Services ("MPS") Level Agreement</u>: Purchasing Entities are subject to the Contractor "Managed Print Service Level Agreement" provided in Participating Addendum **Exhibit B**. Contractor(s) may not provide MPS maintenance or repair Services on any Devices that are being leased or rented to a Purchasing Entity by another Manufacturer, unless they have a written agreement with the Manufacturer to do so.
- 13. MPS Statement of Work Template: All MPS engagements shall require the Contractor and Purchasing Entity to complete a detailed statement of work, similar to the format provided in Participating Addendum Exhibit C (MPS Statement of Work), and it must be approved by both parties prior to the initiation of any engagement.

- 1. Terms Herein Controlling Provisions: It is expressly agreed that the terms of each and every provision in this attachment shall prevail and control over the terms of any other conflicting provision in any other document relating to and a part of the contract in which this attachment is incorporated. Any terms that conflict or could be interpreted to conflict with this attachment are nullified.
- 2. Kansas Law and Venue: This contract shall be subject to, governed by, and construed according to the laws of the State of Kansas, and jurisdiction and venue of any suit in connection with this contract shall reside only in courts located in the State of Kansas.
- 3. Termination Due To Lack Of Funding Appropriation: If, in the judgment of the Director of Accounts and Reports, Department of Administration, sufficient funds are not appropriated to continue the function performed in this agreement and for the payment of the charges hereunder, State may terminate this agreement at the end of its current fiscal year. State agrees to give written notice of termination to contractor at least thirty (30) days prior to the end of its current fiscal year and shall give such notice for a greater period prior to the end of such fiscal year as may be provided in this contract, except that such notice shall not be required prior to ninety (90) days before the end of such fiscal year. Contractor shall have the right, at the end of such fiscal year, to take possession of any equipment provided State under the contract. State will pay to the contractor all regular contractual payments incurred through the end of such fiscal year, plus contractual charges incidental to the return of any such equipment. Upon termination of the agreement by State, title to any such equipment shall revert to contractor at the end of the State's current fiscal year. The termination of the contract pursuant to this paragraph shall not cause any penalty to be charged to the agency or the contractor.
- 4. Disclaimer Of Liability: No provision of this contract will be given effect that attempts to require the State of Kansas or its agencies to defend, hold harmless, or indemnify any contractor or third party for any acts or omissions. The liability of the State of Kansas is defined under the Kansas Tort Claims Act (K.S.A. 75-6101, et seq.).
- 5. Anti-Discrimination Clause: The contractor agrees: (a) to comply with the Kansas Act Against Discrimination (K.S.A. 44-1001, et seq.) and the Kansas Age Discrimination in Employment Act (K.S.A. 44-1111, et seq.)

and the applicable provisions of the Americans With Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. 12101, et seq.) (ADA), and Kansas Executive Order No. 19-02, and to not discriminate against any person because of race, color, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, religion, national origin, ancestry, age, military or veteran status, disability status, marital or family status, genetic information, or political affiliation that is unrelated to the person's ability to reasonably perform the duties of a particular job or position; (b) to include in all solicitations or advertisements for employees, the phrase "equal opportunity employer"; (c) to comply with the reporting requirements set out at K.S.A. 44-1031 and K.S.A. 44-1116; (d) to include those provisions in every subcontract or purchase order so that they are binding upon such subcontractor or vendor; (e) that a failure to comply with the reporting requirements of (c) above or if the contractor is found guilty of any violation of such acts by the Kansas Human Rights Commission, such violation shall constitute a breach of contract and the contract may be cancelled, terminated or suspended, in whole or in part, by the contracting state agency or the Kansas Department of Administration; (f) Contractor agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal antidiscrimination laws and regulations; (g) Contractor agrees all hiring must be on the basis of individual merit and qualifications, and discrimination or harassment of persons for the reasons stated above is prohibited; and (h) if it is determined that the contractor has violated the provisions of any portion of this paragraph, such violation shall constitute a breach of contract and the contract may be canceled, terminated, or suspended, in whole or in part, by the contracting state agency or the Kansas Department of Administration.

- 6. Acceptance of Contract: This contract shall not be considered accepted, approved or otherwise effective until the statutorily required approvals and certifications have been given.
- 7. Arbitration, Damages, Warranties: Notwithstanding any language to the contrary, no interpretation of this contract shall find that the State or its agencies have agreed to binding arbitration, or the payment of damages or penalties. Further, the State of Kansas and its agencies do not agree to pay attorney fees, costs, or late payment charges beyond those available under the Kansas Prompt Payment Act (K.S.A. 75-6403), and no provision will be given effect that attempts to exclude, modify, disclaim or otherwise attempt to limit any damages available to the State of Kansas or its agencies at law, including but not limited to, the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.
- 8. Representative's Authority to Contract: By signing this contract, the representative of the contractor thereby represents that such person is duly authorized by the contractor to execute this contract on behalf of the contractor and that the contractor agrees to be bound by the provisions thereof.
- Responsibility for Taxes: The State of Kansas and its agencies shall not be responsible for, nor indemnify a
 contractor for, any federal, state or local taxes which may be imposed or levied upon the subject matter of this
 contract.
- 10. Insurance: The State of Kansas and its agencies shall not be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to property or any other subject matter relating to this contract, nor shall this contract require them to establish a "self-insurance" fund to protect against any such loss or damage. Subject to the provisions of the Kansas Tort Claims Act (K.S.A. 75-6101, et seq.), the contractor shall bear the risk of any loss or damage to any property in which the contractor holds title.
- 11. INFORMATION: NO PROVISION OF THIS CONTRACT SHALL BE CONSTRUED AS LIMITING THE LEGISLATIVE DIVISION OF POST AUDIT FROM HAVING ACCESS TO INFORMATION PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 46-1101, ET SEQ.
