

PARTICIPATION IN NASPO VALUEPOINT MASTER AGREEMENTS BY UNITS OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT IN THE STATE OF MICHIGAN

The Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) in the Michigan Department of Technology, Management and Budget has notified NASPO ValuePoint that the State has no authority over political subdivisions in Michigan regarding their participation in NASPO ValuePoint cooperative contracts.

Political subdivisions may enter participating addendums to utilize NASPO ValuePoint master agreements, when the State of Michigan does not have an existing participating addendum in place, if doing so follows the procurement authority granted to the unit of local government.

Scanned copies of all executed participating addendums are to be sent by email in PDF format to PA@NASPOValuePoint.org.

This authorization does not apply to any Michigan state agency, department, commission, court, board, council, statutorily created task forces, public university or college without prior consent of the CPO and may be rescinded at any time by the Chief Procurement Officer.
