



**PARTICIPATION IN NASPO VALUEPOINT MASTER AGREEMENTS

IN THE  
STATE OF OHIO**

The Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) in the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, General Services Division, Office of Procurement Services has notified NASPO ValuePoint that the State has no authority over political subdivisions or state institutions of higher education in Ohio regarding their participation in NASPO ValuePoint cooperative contracts.

Political subdivisions and state institutions of higher education may enter participating addendums to utilize NASPO ValuePoint master agreements if doing so follows the procurement authority granted to them.

Non-profit institutions of higher education and other non-profit organizations in Ohio may enter participating addendums to utilize NASPO ValuePoint master agreements with willing contractors.

This authorization does not apply to any state agency or institution in Ohio, and may be rescinded at any time by the Chief Procurement Officer.
