



**PARTICIPATION IN NASPO VALUEPOINT MASTER AGREEMENTS
FOR WIRELESS DATA, VOICE AND ACCESSORIES
BY
ELIGIBLE ENTITIES IN THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA**

The State of South Carolina has informed NASPO ValuePoint that the state has not and will not be executing a Participating Addendum (PA) with a NASPO ValuePoint contractor under this portfolio. However, any local political subdivision (all counties, municipalities, school districts, public service or special purpose districts [11-35-310(24)]) operating under their own independent procurement authority, may make their own determination as to whether they are able to legally participate in any NASPO ValuePoint cooperative contract awarded by the State of Utah for Wireless Data, Voice and Accessories.

A local political subdivision may execute a PA directly with a contractor(s) **only** if doing so complies in all respects with the local political subdivision's legal authority to enter into such agreements. As part of the execution of the PA, the local political subdivision's chief executive official, chief administrative official, chief financial official, or chief procurement official must affirm that the entity has fully complied with all legal requirements for them to execute the PA. **The affirmation language shall be inserted into every PA above the political subdivision's signature to read, "By signing this participating addendum, I affirm doing so complies with my procurement statutes, ordinances, policies or rules."**

This permission is limited to NASPO ValuePoint master agreements awarded under the Wireless Data, Voice and Accessories portfolio led by the State of Utah and does not apply to any other NASPO ValuePoint contract.
