- IV. The administrative fee shall not be included as an adjustment to Contractor's Master Agreement pricing and shall not be invoiced or charged to the ordering agency.
- V. Payment of the administrative fee is due irrespective of payment status on any orders from a Purchasing Entity.
- VI. Administrative fee checks are due for each quarter as follows:

State Fiscal Quarter 4 (Apr 1 - Jun 30):	Jul 31

- VII. Any quarter with zero sales must be reported as zero sales. This may be done electronically via email to the State of Alaska contact listed in this PA.

- 6. Lease Agreements: Entities entitled to purchase under this Participating Addendum that have authority to enter into lease agreements may do so to obtain Products and Services under the Master Agreement.
- 7. Subcontractors: All Fulfillment Partners authorized in the State of Alaska as shown on the dedicated Contractor (cooperative contract) website, are approved to provide sales and service support to participants in the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement. The Fulfillment Partner's participation will be in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the aforementioned Master Agreement.
- 8. Orders: Any order placed by a Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity for a product and/or service available from this Master Agreement shall be deemed to be a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions) of the Master Agreement unless the parties to the order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to such order.

Participating Entities or Purchasing Entities may only place orders directly through Contractor's approved Fulfillment Partners for Products and/or Services as authorized under this Participating Addendum.

- 9. Entire Agreement: The terms and conditions contained in this Participating Addendum and the Master Agreement constitute the entire agreement between the parties concerning the subject matter of this Participating Addendum and supersede all previous and/or contemporaneous agreements and understandings, whether oral or written, between the parties, including but not limited to any preprinted terms on purchase orders, invoices,
