- 2. <u>Participation</u>: This Participating Addendum, as authorized by the Participating Entity's State statutes to utilize the Master Agreement with the prior approval of the State's Chief Procurement Official, may be used by all state agencies, institutions of higher institution, political subdivisions and other entities authorized to use statewide contracts in the Participating Entity's State. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of that State's Chief Procurement Official.
- 3. <u>Term</u>: The initial term of the Master Agreement shall be for three years and is effective from February 28, 2020 through February 27, 2023, with two optional additional one-year renewals. The term of this Participating Addendum will coincide with the Master Agreement's term in its entirety, including any renewals or extensions.
- 4. <u>Pricing</u>: Any products and/or services ordered under this Participating Addendum shall include the Contractor's Master Agreement negotiated percentage discount off the products and/or services available on the Contractor's current price catalog/list (MSRP/MPL).
- 5. <u>Warranty</u>: All products furnished by the Contractor under this Participating Addendum shall be covered by all commercial warranties the Contractor provides for such products under the Master Agreement.
