



**PARTICIPATION IN NASPO VALUEPOINT MASTER AGREEMENTS
BY
MUNICIPALITIES IN THE STATE OF WISCONSIN**

The Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) in the Wisconsin Department of Administration, State Bureau of Procurement (SBP), has notified NASPO ValuePoint that the SBP has no authority over Wisconsin municipalities regarding their participation in NASPO ValuePoint cooperative contracts. This includes counties, cities, villages, towns, school boards, sewage, drainage, vocational, technical, and adult education districts, and other bodies with the power to award public contracts. Participation in NASPO ValuePoint master agreements by Wisconsin municipalities is subject to the municipality's determination of the procurement authority granted to them.

Wisconsin municipalities may establish participating addendums to utilize NASPO ValuePoint master agreements, when the State of Wisconsin does not have an existing participating addendum in place, if doing so follows the procurement authority granted to the unit of local government.
