



**PARTICIPATION IN NASPO VALUEPOINT MASTER AGREEMENTS
BY
UNITS OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT IN THE STATE OF KANSAS**

The Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) in the Kansas Office of Procurement and Contracts (OPC) has notified NASPO ValuePoint that OPC has no authority over political subdivisions in Kansas regarding their participation in NASPO ValuePoint cooperative contracts.

When the OPC establishes a statewide participating addendum for a NASPO ValuePoint contract, Kansas political subdivisions are eligible to utilize the agreement as they would other State of Kansas contracts.

Kansas political subdivisions wishing to participate in a NASPO ValuePoint contract for which the OPC has not executed a participating addendum should notify OPC of the political subdivision's interest in participating in a specific NASPO ValuePoint contract and requesting OPC consider execution of a statewide participating addendum.

If OPC decides not to execute a statewide participating addendum, a Kansas political subdivision shall make an independent determination as to their legal authority to execute a participating addendum directly with a NASPO ValuePoint contractor. OPC will neither approve nor deny a political subdivision's participation in any NASPO ValuePoint contract.
