4. Shipping - Free on Board

Contractor is responsible for transportation and handling charges, and the sale does not occur until the products arrive at the Purchasing Entity's specified location.

5. Required Reports

Contractor must submit quarterly reports to the Contracting Officer assigned by the State of to manage this contract. The contractor shall provide the State of Alaska with an electronic usage report (excel) which will list the following information at the minimum: Purchasing entity, description of items purchased, date of purchase, contract price, retail price, and extended price for each transaction. These reports are due 30 days after the end of the quarter.

6. Administrative Fee:

Contractor agrees to provide an Administrative Fee to the State of Alaska.

- a. Contractor shall submit a check, payable to the State of Alaska, remitted to the Department of Administration, Division of General Services for the calculated amount equal to 1.5% of the net sales for the quarterly period.
- b. Contractor must include the **Contract Name (Body Armor)** and **PA Number (2021BA07)** on the check. Those checks submitted to the State without these identifiers will be returned to the contractor for additional identifying information.
