

## PARTICIPATION IN NASPO VALUEPOINT MASTER AGREEMENTS BY POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS IN THE STATE OF IDAHO

The State Purchasing Administrator in the Idaho Division of Purchasing has notified NASPO ValuePoint that Idaho political subdivisions may enter into direct participating addendums (PA) with any NASPO ValuePoint contractor under the Copiers & Managed Print Services (2019-2024) contract portfolio that has not already been awarded a contract/PA by the Division of Purchasing.

Participation in any other NASPO ValuePoint master agreement/portfolio is subject to the prior approval of the Purchasing Administrator.

The Purchasing Administrator has also notified NASPO ValuePoint that Idaho non-profit organizations are not eligible to participate in Idaho state contracts, including state issued Participating Addendums with NASPO ValuePoint contractors. The Administrator has indicated there is no objection to a NASPO ValuePoint contractor entering into a direct Participating Addendum with an Idaho non-profit organization if allowed by the contractor's master agreement.

This authorization may be rescinded at any time.
