Amendment \#2 of Master Agreement (Master Agreement \#19-19-04) for Procurement of Acquisition Support Services (PASS), is made and entered into by and between the Lead State acting by and through the Department of Accounting and General Services, State Procurement Office, a State of Hawaii governmental agency ("State") on behalf of the NASPO ValuePoint Cooperative Purchasing Program.

## AGREEMENT

1. Amendment - Term of the Master Agreement. The Master Agreement has a base period of two (2) years and shall terminate unless it is extended. Per the term of the Master Agreement, the Master Agreement may be extended for up to three (3) additional 12-month periods or parts thereof at the Lead State's discretion, by mutual agreement and upon review of requirements of Participating Entities, current market conditions, and Contractor Performance. The Lead State has made the determination and chooses to exercise the second 12-month optional period to extend the Master Agreement from June 6, 2022 to June 5, 2023.
2. Amendment - Hourly Rates:
a. Per the Master Agreement, all labor category rates must be guaranteed for the initial term and additional years of the Master Agreement.
b. Hourly rates in optional periods were allowed to be adjusted at no more than a 2\% inflation rate. See Exhibit 2 for rates for Year 4 applicable to this amendment and extension period.
c. All rates shall be guaranteed for each year as part of the Master Agreement. Requests for price adjustment, other than the adjusted price offered shall not be considered.
