By signing and entering into this Participating Addendum, the Participating Entity certifies that they have obtained all of the acknowledgements and approvals required by state or local law or regulation. Purchasing Entity will immediately notify Contractor of any change in its eligibility to purchase under this Participating Addendum. Contractor reserves the right to terminate a Purchasing Entity's ability to purchase under this Participating Addendum if at any time it is determined that Purchasing Entity is not eligible to purchase under this Participating Addendum.

- f) Any quarter with zero sales must be reported as zero sales. This may be done electronically via email to the State of Alaska contact listed in this PA.
- 3) Shipping is to be FOB destination
- 4) Non-Appropriation of Funds: The Contractor acknowledges that the Purchasing Entity cannot contract for the payment of funds not yet appropriated. If funding is reduced due to an order by the Legislature or the Governor, or is required by State law, or if federal funding (when applicable) is not provided for a subsequent fiscal year, the Purchasing Entity may terminate this contract or proportionately reduce the services and purchase obligations from the State at the end of the then current fiscal year upon thirty (30) days written notice. In the case that funds are not appropriated for a subsequent fiscal year or are reduced for a subsequent fiscal year, the Purchasing Entity will reimburse Contractor for products delivered or services performed through the date of cancellation or reduction, and the Purchasing Entity will not be liable for any future commitments, penalties, or liquidated damages.

Any limitations, modifications, or additions specified herein apply only to the agreement and relationship between Participating Entity and Contractor and shall not amend or affect other participating addendums or the Master Agreement itself.
