- Scope: This addendum covers the Nationwide Vehicle Rental Services led by the State of Oregon for
 use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating State of Iowa authorized by that
 State's statutes to utilize State contracts with the prior approval of the State's Chief Procurement
 Official.
- Participation: This NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement may be used by all state agencies, institutions of higher institution, political subdivisions and other entities authorized to use statewide contracts in the State of Iowa. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.
- 3. <u>Agreement Length</u>: The Agreement shall include the initial period and any annual renewal periods approved by the Lead State and NASPO ValuePoint up to a maximum of four (4) renewal periods. The maximum Agreement length including renewal periods is six (6) years.

A. Administrative Fee

The Contractor shall provide the state of Iowa with a 1.00% rebate on all sales made within the state of Iowa against this Agreement. The rebate is to be paid quarterly to: CFO - Central Procurement Bureau, Iowa Department of Administrative Services, Central Procurement Bureau, Floor 3, 1305 E. Walnut, Des Moines, IA 50319-0105.

B. Quarterly Sales Report

The Contractor shall provide the Participating Entity with quarterly sales reports which contain the following fields:

- Purchasing Entity Name
- Location of Rental
- Date of Rental
- Type of Vehicle Rented (sedan, pickup, van, etc.)
- Length of rental
- Unit price (rental rate) and extended total
- Total Dollars In Rental Fees Per Quarter

The report shall be sent to the current contract manager at the Participating Entity within 45 days after the quarter ends. Quarters end on March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31 annually.

C. Pricing

Contractor's stated prices shall be price lists approved and agreed to with NASPO ValuePoint under the Master Price Agreement with an additional one percent (1%) administrative fee.

D. Payment

Payment after acceptance is normally made within 30 days following the date the entire order is delivered or the date a correct invoice is received, whichever is later. Per Iowa Code § 8A.514 the State of Iowa is allowed sixty (60) days to pay an invoice submitted by a vendor. The State of Iowa shall pay all approved invoices in arrears and in conformance with Iowa Code 8A.514. The State of Iowa may pay in less than sixty (60) days, but an election to pay in less than sixty (60) days shall not act as an implied waiver of Iowa Code § 8A.514. Payments may be remitted by mail or electronic transfer or may be made via a State or political subdivision "Purchasing Card" with no additional charge.

E. Certificate of Liability Insurance

The Contractor shall furnish the Participating Entity with a current Certificate of Liability Insurance indicating the following insurance coverages which may be provided by Contractor via either policies of insurance or as a self-insurer:

The Contractor shall send an updated COI to the Participating Entity's Contract Manager prior to expiration of the current COI for the duration of the Participating Addendum and any renewal periods.

F. Authorized Point-of-Sale

The Contractor's locations, whether independently or corporate owned, will participate in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the aforementioned Master Agreement and this Addendum.

G. Choice of Law and Forum

The laws of the State of Iowa shall govern and determine all matters arising out of or in connection with this Participating Addendum without regard to the conflict of law provisions of Iowa law. Any and all litigation commenced in connection with this Participating Addendum shall be brought and maintained solely in Polk County District Court for the State of Iowa, Des Moines, Iowa, or in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Iowa, Central Division, Des Moines Iowa, wherever jurisdiction is appropriate. This provision shall not be construed as waiving any immunity to suit or liability including without limitation sovereign immunity in State or Federal court, which may be available to the Participating State.

H. Termination upon Notice

Following thirty (30) days written notice, the Agency may terminate this Participating Addendum in whole or in part without penalty and without incurring any further obligation to Contractor. Termination can be for any reason or no reason at all.

I. Setoff Against Sums Owed by the Contractor

In the event that Contractor owes the Participating State any sum under the terms of this Participating Addendum, any other contract or agreement, pursuant to a judgment, or pursuant to any law, the Participating State may, in its sole discretion, set off any such sum against:

- 12.1 Any sum invoiced by, or owed to, Contractor under this Participating Addendum, or
- 12.2 Any sum or amount owed by the Participating State to Contractor, unless otherwise required by law.

The Contractor agrees that this provision constitutes proper and timely notice under any applicable laws governing setoff.

J. Subcontractors

All Contractor dealers and resellers authorized in the State of Iowa, as shown on the dedicated Contractor (cooperative contract) website, are approved to provide sales and service support to participants in the NASPO ValuePoint Master Price Agreement. The Contractor's dealer's participation will be in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the aforementioned Master Price Agreement.

K. Orders:

Any Order placed by a Participating State for a Service available from the Master Price Agreement is a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions) of the Master Price Agreement unless the parties to the Order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to such Order.
