 Section 19. EXECUTIVE ORDER N-6-22 – RUSSIA SANCTIONS is hereby added to read as follows:

19. EXECUTIVE ORDER N-6-22 - RUSSIA SANCTIONS

On March 4, 2022, Governor Gavin Newsom issued Executive Order N-6-22 (the EO) regarding Economic Sanctions against Russia and Russian entities and individuals. "Economic Sanctions" refers to sanctions imposed by the U.S. government in response to Russia's actions in Ukraine, as well as any sanctions imposed under state law. The EO directs state agencies to terminate contracts with, and to refrain from entering any new contracts with, individuals or entities that are determined to be a target of Economic Sanctions. Accordingly, should the State determine Contractor is a target of Economic Sanctions or is conducting prohibited transactions with sanctioned individuals or entities, that shall be grounds for termination of this Participating Addendum. The State shall provide Contractor advance written notice of such termination, allowing Contractor at least thirty (30) calendar days to provide a written response. Termination shall be at the sole discretion of the State.

This Participating Addendum Number 7-17-70-42-07 is entered into between the state of California, Department of General Services (hereafter referred to as "State" or "DGS") and WatchGuard, Inc. (hereafter referred to as "Contractor") under the lead state of Oklahoma NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement Number OK-MA-145-010.

1. SCOPE

- A. This Participating Addendum covers the purchase of Public Safety Video Equipment under the Oklahoma NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement. The Oklahoma NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement Number OK-MA-145-010 is hereby incorporated by reference. Product/service categories included under this Participating Addendum are identified in Section 5 (Available Products and Services).
- B. This Participating Addendum is available for use by California State agencies and local governments. A local government is defined as any city, county, city and county, district, or other local governmental body, school district or corporation empowered to expend public funds. The State Agency Listing (https://www.ca.gov/agenciesall/) provides a comprehensive list of state agencies.
- C. Each local government is to make its own determination whether this Participating Addendum and the Oklahoma NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement are consistent with its procurement policies and regulations.

2. TERM

- A. The term of this Participating Addendum shall begin upon signature approval by the State and will end January 31, 2020, or upon termination by the State, whichever occurs first.
- B. Lead State amendments to extend the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement term date are automatically incorporated into this Participating Addendum.
- C. Order placement and execution shall be on or before the expiration of this Participating Addendum. However, delivery of products or completion of services may be after the Participating Addendum expiration date.

4. ORDER OF PRECEDENCE

In the event of any inconsistency between the articles, attachments, or provisions which constitute this agreement, the following descending order of precedence shall apply:

- B. Oklahoma NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement Number OK-MA-145-010
- C. Oklahoma Solicitation OK-MA-145 including all Addendums
- D. Contractor's response to the Oklahoma Solicitation

5. AVAILABLE PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

- A. The following product and service offerings from the Oklahoma NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement Number OK-MA-145-010 are allowed under this Participating Addendum:
 - 1) Band 1: Body Worn Video Cameras and Recording Devices
 - 2) Band 2: Vehicle Mounted Video and Recording Devices
 - 3) Band 3: Video Storage, Data Security, Software and Peripherals

6. RESTRICTIONS/DISALLOWED PRODUCTS AND SERVICES (State Agencies Only)

- A. Product and service categories available on mandatory California statewide contracts cannot be purchased from this Participating Addendum by State agencies without an exemption. As applicable, State agencies are responsible for obtaining an exemption from DGS or the California Department of Technology prior to issuing a purchase order. This restriction is not applicable to local governments.
- B. Installation services that fall within the definition of "public works" as defined in Public Contract Code, Section 1101 and Labor Code Section 1720 are disallowed under this cooperative agreement and must be procured by alternate means. This restriction is not applicable to local governments.

7. PRICING

- A. Contractor shall notify State Contract Administrator when NASPO ValuePoint lead state Contract Administrator has approved revisions to the Master Agreement Price List.
- B. The Price List shall include the following:
 - 1) Manufacturer Part Number or Item Number
 - 2) List Price
 - 3) Discount off List Price
 - 4) Contract Price

8. EQUIPMENT ADDITIONS/DELETIONS

- A. Contractor may add or delete equipment introduced or removed from the market by the manufacturer under the following conditions:
 - Equipment is within existing awarded categories under the NASPO ValuePoint Master Price Agreement;
 - Contractor has obtained prior approval from the Oklahoma NASPO ValuePoint Contract Administrator; and
- B. Contractor shall not add new categories or groups of equipment or services under this Participating Addendum that were not originally included in the Oklahoma NASPO Valuepoint Master Agreement.

9. AUTHORIZED RESELLERS

Authorized Resellers are not available for this Participating Addendum.

10. ORDERING AGENCY RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. State agency and local government use of this Participating Addendum is optional.
- B. State agency and local governments must follow the ordering procedures outlined within the User Instructions guide, administered by the State Contract Administrator, to execute orders against this Participating Addendum.

11.DELIVERY

- A. Delivery shall occur within 30 days after receipt of order, or as negotiated between ordering agency and contractor and included in the purchase order, or as otherwise stipulated in the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement.
- B. Free On Board Destination (F.O.B.)

12. INVOICING AND PAYMENT

- A. Payment terms for this Participating Addendum are net forty-five (45) days. Payment will be made in accordance with Paragraph 30 (Required Payment Date) of the GSPD-401IT terms and conditions.
- B. Invoices shall be sent to the address identified in the Ordering Agency's purchase order. The State Participating Addendum Number and Ordering Agency Purchase Order Number shall appear on each invoice for all purchases placed under this Participating Addendum.
- C. Contractor does not accept the State of California credit card (CAL-Card) for payment of invoices.

13. USAGE REPORTING

- A. Contractor shall submit usage reports on a quarterly basis to the State Contract Administrator for all California entity purchases using the report template attached hereto as Attachment A. The report is due even when there is no activity.
- B. The DGS Contract Administrator reserves the right to modify this report and require Contractor to provide additional order information during the course of this Agreement.
- C. The report shall be an Excel spreadsheet transmitted electronically to the DGS mailbox at PDCooperatives@dgs.ca.gov.
- D. Any report that does not follow the required format or that excludes information will be deemed incomplete. Contractor will be responsible for submitting

corrected reports within five business days of the date of written notification from the State.

- E. Tax must not be included in the report, even if it is on the purchase order.
- F. Reports are due for each quarter as follows:

- A. Contractor shall submit a check, payable to the State of California, remitted to the Cooperative Agreement Unit for the calculated amount equal to 1.25% of the sales for the quarterly period.
- B. Contractor must include the Participating Addendum Number on the check. Those checks submitted to the State without the Participating Addendum Number will be returned to Contractor for additional identifying information.
